vs 1

John 10:17-18-For this reason the Father loves Me, because I lay down My life so that I may take it again. <sup>18</sup> No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father.”

vs 2

Heb. 10:5-9-Therefore, when He comes into the world, He says, “SACRIFICE AND OFFERING YOU HAVE NOT DESIRED, BUT A BODY YOU HAVE PREPARED FOR ME; <sup>6</sup> IN WHOLE BURNT OFFERINGS AND *sacrifices* FOR SIN YOU HAVE TAKEN NO PLEASURE. <sup>7</sup> “THEN I SAID, ‘BEHOLD, I HAVE COME (IN THE SCROLL OF THE BOOK IT IS WRITTEN OF ME) TO DO YOUR WILL, O GOD.’”<sup>8</sup> After saying above, “SACRIFICES AND OFFERINGS AND WHOLE BURNT OFFERINGS AND *sacrifices* FOR SIN YOU HAVE NOT DESIRED, NOR HAVE YOU TAKEN PLEASURE *in them*” (which are offered according to the Law), <sup>9</sup> then He <sup>[a]</sup>said,

“BEHOLD, I HAVE COME TO DO YOUR WILL.” He takes away the first in order to establish the second.

vs. 4

John 1:48-49-Nathanael \*said to Him, “How do You know me?” Jesus answered and said to him, “Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you.”<sup>49</sup> Nathanael answered Him, “Rabbi, You are the Son of God; You are the King of Israel.”

John 2:24-25-But Jesus, on His part, was not entrusting Himself to them, for He knew all men,<sup>25</sup> and because He did not need anyone to testify concerning man, for He Himself knew what was in man.

John 10:17-18-For this reason the Father loves Me, because I lay down My life so that I may take it again.<sup>18</sup> No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father.”

John 8:59- Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus <sup>[f]</sup>hid Himself and went out of the temple.

John 2:4- And Jesus \*said to her, “Woman, <sup>[a]</sup>what does that have to do with us? My hour has not yet come.”

John 7:6- So Jesus \*said to them, “My time is not yet here, but your time is always opportune.

John 13:1- Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He would depart out of this world to

the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them <sup>[a]</sup>to the end

John 17:1- Jesus spoke these things; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, “Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, that the Son may glorify You

vs. 5-6

Exod. 3:14- God said to Moses, “[a]I AM WHO <sup>[b]</sup>I AM”; and He said, “Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, ‘<sup>[c]</sup>I AM has sent me to you.’”

John 8:58-59- Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham <sup>[q]</sup>was born, I am.” <sup>59</sup> Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus <sup>[r]</sup>hid Himself and went out of the temple.

Constable- They probably "drew back and fell" because, being shocked, they could not believe that the man they had come out for, expecting to have to hunt for, was virtually surrendering to them.

Ps 27:2- When evildoers came upon me to devour my flesh, My adversaries and my enemies, they stumbled and fell.

vs. 7-9

John 17:12- While I was with them, I was keeping them in Your name which You have given Me; and I guarded them and not one of them perished but the <sup>[a]</sup>son of perdition, so that the Scripture would be fulfilled.

Isa 53:3-6- He was despised and forsaken of men, A man of <sup>[a]</sup>sorrows and acquainted with <sup>[b]</sup>grief; And like one from whom men hide their face He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.<sup>4</sup> Surely our <sup>[c]</sup>griefs He Himself bore, And our <sup>[d]</sup>sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, <sup>[e]</sup>Smitten of God, and afflicted.<sup>5</sup> But He was <sup>[f]</sup>pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our <sup>[g]</sup>well-being *fell* upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed.<sup>6</sup> All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To <sup>[h]</sup>fall on Him.

John 6:37- All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out.

John 6:39- This is the will of Him who sent Me, that of all that He has given Me I lose nothing, but raise it up on the last day

John 10:27-29- My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me; <sup>28</sup> and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand.

<sup>29</sup> <sup>[d]</sup>My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of the Father's hand. <sup>30</sup> I and the Father are <sup>[e]</sup>one.”

John 5:39- You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; it is these that testify about Me

John 5:46- For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me, for he wrote about Me.

Luke 24:27- Then beginning <sup>[g]</sup>with Moses and <sup>[h]</sup>with all the prophets, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.

Luke 24:44- Now He said to them, “These are My words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things which are written about Me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled.”

vs. 10-11-

Matt. 20:22-23- But Jesus answered, “You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I am about to drink?” They \*said to Him, “We are able.” <sup>23</sup> He \*said to them, “My cup you shall drink; but to sit on My right and on My left, this is not Mine to give, but it is for those for whom it has been prepared by My Father.”

Matt. 16:21-22- From that time <sup>[r]</sup>Jesus began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised up on the third day. <sup>22</sup> Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, “<sup>[s]</sup>God forbid *it*, Lord! This shall never <sup>[t]</sup>happen to You.”

John 13:37-38- Peter \*said to Him, “Lord, why can I not follow You right now? I will lay down my life for You.” <sup>38</sup> Jesus \*answered, “Will you lay down your life for Me? Truly, truly, I say to you, a rooster will not crow until you deny Me three times.

John 18:27- Peter then denied *it* again, and immediately a rooster crowed.

Matt. 26:75- And Peter remembered the word which Jesus had said, “Before a rooster crows, you will deny Me three times.” And he went out and wept bitterly.

Heb. 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep <sup>[a]</sup>through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, <sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever.
