2 Cor. 4:4- in whose case the **god of this ^[b]world** has blinded the minds of the unbelieving ^[c]so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

Luke 4:5-8- And he led Him up and showed Him all the kingdoms of ^[b]the world in a moment of time. ⁶ And the devil said to Him, “**I will give You all this domain and ^[c]its glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I give it to whomever I wish.**”⁷ Therefore if You ^[d]worship before me, it shall all be Yours.”⁸ **Jesus answered him,** “It is written, ‘YOU SHALL WORSHIP THE LORD YOUR GOD AND SERVE HIM ONLY.’”

John 12:31-Now judgment is upon this world; now **the ruler of this world** will be cast out.

Rev. 5:10- You have made them *to be* a kingdom and priests to our God; and they will reign upon the earth.

Rev. 11:15- Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “**The kingdom of the world has become *the kingdom* of our Lord and of His ^[j]Christ; and He**

will reign forever and ever.”¹⁶ And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God.

1 Cor. 15:45- So also it is written, “The first MAN, Adam, BECAME A LIVING SOUL.” **The last Adam** *became* a life-giving spirit.

Dan. 9:20-23- Now while I was speaking and praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and ^[n]presenting my supplication before the LORD my God in behalf of the holy mountain of my God,²¹ while I was still speaking in prayer, then the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision ^[o]previously, ^[p]came to me ^[q]in *my* extreme weariness about the time of the evening offering.²² He gave *me* instruction and talked with me and said, “O Daniel, I have now come forth to give you insight with understanding.²³ At the beginning of your supplications the ^[r]command was issued, and I have come to tell *you*, for you are ^[s]highly esteemed; so give heed to the message and gain understanding of the vision.

Gen. 2:16-17- The LORD God commanded the man, saying, “From any tree of the garden you may eat freely;¹⁷ but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not ^[n]eat, for in the day that you eat from it **you will surely die.**

Ezek. 18:20- **The person who sins will die.** The son will not bear the punishment for the father’s iniquity, nor will the father bear the punishment for the son’s iniquity; the righteousness of

the righteous will be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked will be upon himself.

Jas. 1:14-15- But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust. ¹⁵ Then when lust has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and when sin ^[p]is accomplished, it brings forth **death**.

Rom. 6:23- For **the wages of sin is death**, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Heb. 9:27- And inasmuch as **it is ^[y]appointed for men to die once and after this comes judgment**.

John 11:25-26- Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, ²⁶ and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?”

John 1:14- **And the Word became flesh, and ^[k]dwelt among us, and we saw His glory**, glory as of ^[l]the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth. ¹⁵ John *testified about Him and cried out, saying, “This was He of whom I said, ‘He who comes after me ^[m]has a higher rank than I, for He existed before me.’”

1 Tim 4:10- For it is for this we labor and strive, because we have fixed our hope on the living God, **who is the Savior of all men, especially of believers**.

1 John 2:2-and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for *those of* the **whole world**.

Matt. 12:46-50- While He was still speaking to the crowds, behold, His mother and brothers were standing outside, seeking to speak to Him. ⁴⁷ Someone said to Him, “Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside seeking to speak to You.”^[ao] ⁴⁸ But ^[ap] Jesus answered the one who was telling Him and said, “Who is My mother and who are My brothers?” ⁴⁹ And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, “Behold My mother and My brothers! ⁵⁰ For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My brother and sister and mother.”

Rom. 8:29-30- For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to become* conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be **the firstborn among many brethren**; ³⁰ and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.

John 17:5- Now, Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

Rev. 5:2-4- And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, “Who is worthy to open the ^[c]book and to break its seals?” ³ And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the ^[d]book or to look into it. ⁴ Then I *began* to

weep greatly because no one was found worthy to open the [e]book or to look into it

Rev. 5:5-7- and one of the elders *said to me, “Stop weeping; behold, the Lion that is from the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome so as to open the [f]book and its seven seals.”⁶ And I saw [g]between the throne (with the four living creatures) and the elders a Lamb standing, as if slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth. ⁷ And He came and took the book out of the right hand of Him who sat on the throne.

John 11:25-26- Jesus said to her, “**I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, ²⁶ and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die.** Do you believe this?”

2 Cor. 5:8- we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather **to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.**

Philip. 1:21-23- For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. ²² [s]But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know [t]which to choose. ²³ But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for *that* is very much better.

Heb. 4:15-16- For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as *we are*, yet without sin. ¹⁶ Therefore let us draw

near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

1 John 2:2-and He Himself is the **propitiation** for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for *those of* the whole world.

Propitiation-The cross has pacified, appeased, and placated God's anger against sin so that His wrath has been diverted from us.

Rom. 3:25- whom God displayed publicly as a ^[n]**propitiation** ^[o]in His blood through faith. *This was* to demonstrate His righteousness, ^[p]because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed.

John 19:30-Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, “**It is finished!**” And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

Ps. 40:6- Sacrifice and meal offering You have not desired; My ears You have ^[e]opened; Burnt offering and sin offering You have not required.

Titus 2:14- who gave Himself for us to redeem us from **every** lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

Col. 2:13- When you were dead ^[k]in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us **all** our transgressions

John 19:30-Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.
