

The Dragnet:
The coexistence of the righteous and the wicked only to be separated at the age's conclusion

1 Tim. 4:1-But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will ^[a]fall away from **the faith**, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons.

Jude 4-For certain persons have crept in unnoticed, those who were long beforehand ^[a]marked out for this condemnation, ungodly persons who turn the grace of our God into licentiousness and **deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ**.

2 Peter 2:1-But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will also be false teachers among you, who will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even **denying the Master who bought them**, bringing swift destruction upon themselves.

2 Peter 3:3-4-Know this first of all, that in the last days mockers will come with *their* mocking, following after their own lusts, ⁴ and saying, “**Where is the promise of His coming?** For *ever* since the fathers fell asleep, all continues just as it was from the beginning of creation.”

2 Tim. 4:3-4- For the time will come when **they will not endure sound doctrine**; but *wanting* to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, ⁴ and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths.

2 Tim. 2:16-18-But avoid worldly *and* empty chatter, for ^[e]it will lead to further ungodliness, ¹⁷ and their ^[f]talk will spread like ^[g]gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus,

¹⁸ *men* who have gone astray from the truth saying that the **resurrection has already taken place**, and they upset the faith of some.

2 Peter 3:5-For this **they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water** (NKJV)

Judges 18:30-The sons of Dan set up for themselves the graven image; and **Jonathan, the son of Gershom, the son of [p]Manasseh**, he and his sons were priests to the tribe of the Danites until the day of the captivity of the land.

Rev. 2:4-5-ut I have *this* against you, that you have left your first love. ⁵ Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the ^[d]deeds you did at first; or else I am coming to you and will remove your lampstand out of its place—unless you repent.

Matt. 16:21-23-From that time on Jesus began to explain to his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life. Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. “Never, Lord!” he said. “This shall never happen to you!” Jesus turned and said to Peter, “**Get behind me, Satan!** You are a stumbling

block to me; you do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns.”

Acts 5:3-Then Peter said, “Ananias, how is it that **Satan has so filled your heart** that you have lied to the Holy Spirit and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land?

Acts 5:11-Great fear seized the whole church and all who heard about these events.

Eph. 4:26-27-BE ANGRY, AND *yet* DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger,²⁷ and **do not give the devil ^[s]an opportunity.**

2 Tim. 2:15-Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.

2 Tim. 3:17- so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

1 Thess. 5:21- But **examine everything** *carefully*; hold fast to that which is good

Rom. 12:2-And do not be conformed to this ^[c]world, but **be transformed by the renewing of your mind**, so that you may ^[d]prove what the will of God is, that which is good and ^[e]acceptable and perfect.

Eph. 6:11- **Put on the full armor of God**, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.

Jude 3- Beloved, while I was making every effort to write you about our common salvation, I felt the necessity to write to you appealing that you **contend earnestly for the faith** which was once for all handed down to the ^[a]saints.

Num. 6:24-26-“““The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the LORD turn his face toward you and give you peace.””
