

 - Habitual Sin 2 Pet 2:7; 1 Cor. 3:15; 6:19





Similar Yet Different System

- Texas v. California example
- Differences:
 - Ceremonial & civil
 - Punitive (Num. 15:32-36)
 - Empowerment (Gal 5:16)
- NT system given a different name
 - Law of Christ (Gal. 6:2)
 - Law of the Spirit (Rom. 8:2)
