Sessions asked Panetta if he could "initiate a no-fly zone in Syria" without Congressional approval. "Again, our goal would be to seek international permission and we would ...come to the Congress and inform you and determine how best to approach this, whether or not we would want to get permission from the Congress...," Panetta said. "I'm almost breathless about that," Sessions responded. "What I heard you say is, we're going to seek international approval and then we'll come and tell the Congress what we might do and we might seek Congressional approval."


Panetta explained that if U.S. forces are working as part of an international coalition, then the administration would want "to get the appropriate permissions," which he said is something "all of these countries would want." Sessions pressed the issue and asked "what entity" the administration would seek permission from, Sessions said he was all in favor of international support, but added that he was "baffled by the idea that somehow, an international assembly" would provide a legal basis for the deployment of the U.S. military. Sessions responded that international bodies "provide no legal authority" to deploy U.S. military into combat operations.

A. National Sovereignty

1. Divine Purpose Behind Globalism

Deut 32:8-When the Most High gave the <u>nations</u> their inheritance, <u>When He separated the sons of ^[c]man, He set the boundaries of the peoples</u> According to the number of the sons of Israel

Acts 17:26-and He made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined their appointed times and the **boundaries** of their habitation.

Ps. 2:8-Ask of Me, and I will surely give the [f] nations as Your inheritance, And the *very* ends of the earth as Your possession.

Rev. 21:24-The <u>nations</u> will walk by its light, and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it.

Scalia-To hear Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia tell it, America's freedoms don't come from freedom of speech or freedom of the press. It's not the right to bear arms that keeps us free, nor is it the right to "be secure ... against unreasonable search and seizure" or to a "speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury." The reason America's basic freedom has endured for more than 200 years, Scalia said...in a speech to the Federalist Society in Morristown, N.J., is not the amendments to the Constitution but the Constitution itself. "Every tin horn dictator in the world today, every president for life, has a Bill of Rights,"..."That's not what makes us free; if it did, you would rather live in Zimbabwe. But you wouldn't want to live in most countries in the world that have a Bill of Rights. What has made us free is our Constitution. Think of the word 'constitution;' it means structure." That's why America's framers debated not the Bill of Rights during the Constitutional Convention of 1787 in Philadelphia, he said, but rather the structure of the federal government. "The genius of the American constitutional system is the dispersal of power," he said. "Once power is centralized in one person, or one part [of government], a Bill of Rights is just words on paper."..."A constitution is about setting structure; it is not about writing the preferences of special interest groups," he said.1

Monet method- The strategy used to convince once sovereign nations into surrendering their sovereignty to an economic and political entity or region larger than themselves is known as the "Monet Method," which is named after Jean Monet (1888–1970) who was the father of the European Union. The Monet method is a deceptive one that cloaks the agenda of regionalism behind the advocacy of free trade agreements between countries.

5. Good News
