Why Christians Support for Israel

<u>1. The Divine Purpose for Israel</u>

Isaiah 43:1-But now, thus says the LORD, your <u>**Creator**</u>, O Jacob, And He who formed you, O Israel, "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are Mine!

Isaiah 43:15-I am the LORD, your Holy One, The <u>**Creator**</u> of Israel, your King.

Ezek 5:5-Thus says the Lord [f]GOD, 'This is Jerusalem; I have set her <u>at the center of the nations</u>, with lands around her.'

Ezek 38:12-to capture spoil and to seize plunder, to turn your hand against the waste places which are *now* inhabited, and against the people who are gathered from the nations, who have acquired cattle and goods, <u>who live at the ^[k]center of the</u> world.

The Hebrew word translated "center" is literally the <u>**navel**</u> or belly button, which refers to the center of the body.

2. The Divine Protection of Israel

Gen 12:3-And I will bless those who bless you, And the one who curses you I will curse.

Zech. 2:8-_For thus says the LORD of hosts, "After ^[e]glory He has sent me against the nations which plunder you, f<u>or he who</u> touches you, touches the apple of His eye.

On August 18, 1790, congregants of the Touro Synagogue of Newport, Rhode Island, warmly welcomed <u>George Washington</u>

to both their place of worship and their city. Washington's letter of response to the synagogue, delivered on the same day, has become famous for reinforcing the ideal of religious liberty in American life...From its publication to the present, Washington's letter has remained a touchstone of American Jewish life. More than one historian has described the letter as the single most important document in American Jewish history...Its words have been cited by Supreme Court justices in at least three religious liberty cases.

Letter to the Hebrew Congregation of Newport, Rhode Island August 18, 1790

"I rejoice in the opportunity of assuring you, that I shall always retain a grateful remembrance of the cordial welcome I experienced in my visit to Newport...the Government of the United States, which gives to bigotry no sanction, to persecution no assistance...May the Children of the Stock of Abraham, who dwell in this land, continue to merit and enjoy the good will of the other Inhabitants; while every one shall sit in safety under his own vine and figtree, and there shall be none to make him afraid."

3. The Proper Perspective Concerning Israel

a. Attitude

Rom. 11:17-20, 23-24-But if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive, were grafted in among them and became partaker with them of the ^[h]rich root of the olive tree, ¹⁸ do not be arrogant toward the branches; but if you are arrogant, *remember that* it is not you who supports the root, but

the root *supports* you.¹⁹ You will say then, "Branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in." ²⁰ Quite right, they were broken off for their unbelief, but you stand by your faith. Do not be conceited, but fear; ²³ And they also, if they do not continue in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again. ²⁴ For if you were cut off from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these who are the natural *branches* be grafted into their own olive tree?

Rom. 15:26-27-_For Macedonia and Achaia have been pleased to make a contribution for the poor among the ^[m]saints in <u>Jerusalem</u>. ²⁷ Yes, they were pleased *to do so*, and they are indebted to them. <u>For if the Gentiles have shared in their</u> <u>spiritual things, they are indebted to minister to them also in</u> <u>material things</u>.

b. Angelic conflict

Matt. 23:38-39-_Behold, your house is being left to you desolate! ³⁹ For I say to you, from now on you will not see Me until you say, 'BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!'"

c. Apostate condition

Ezek. 36:24-26-For I will take you from the nations, gather you from all the lands and bring you into your own land. ²⁵ Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. ²⁶ Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of

flesh. ²⁷ I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances. ²⁸ You will live in the land that I gave to your forefathers; so you will be My people, and I will be your God.

Ezek 37:1-14- The hand of the LORD was upon me, and He brought me out ^[a]by the Spirit of the LORD and set me down in the middle of the valley; and it was full of bones.² He caused me to pass among them round about, and behold, *there were* very many on the surface of the valley; and lo, *they were* very dry. ³He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" And I answered, "O Lord ^[b]GOD, You know." ⁴ Again He said to me, "Prophesy over these bones and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.' ⁵ Thus says the Lord GOD to these bones, 'Behold, I will cause ^[c]breath to enter you that you may come to life. ⁶I will put sinews on you, make flesh grow back on you, cover you with skin and put breath in you that you may come alive; and you will know that I am the LORD."⁷ So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a ^[d]noise, and behold, a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to its bone.⁸ And I looked, and behold, sinews were on them, and flesh grew and skin covered them; but there was no breath in them.⁹ Then He said to me, "Prophesy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they come to life."" ¹⁰ So I prophesied as He commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they came to life and stood on their feet, an exceedingly great army.¹¹ Then He said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel; behold, they say, 'Our bones are dried up and our hope has perished. We are ^[e] completely cut off.' ¹² Therefore

prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "Behold, I will open your graves and cause you to come up out of your graves, My people; and I will bring you into the land of Israel. ¹³ Then you will know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves and caused you to come up out of your graves, My people. ¹⁴ I will put My ^[f]Spirit within you and you will come to life, and I will place you on your own land. Then you will know that I, the LORD, have spoken and done it," declares the LORD."

In a conversation on religious questions, Fredric II, King of Prussia (1740-1786) asked Joachim von Zieten, General of the Husars, whom he esteemed highly as a Christian for his plain and uncompromised views, "Give me proof for the truth of the Bible in two words!" To which Zeiten replied, "<u>Your majesty, the Jews!</u>"

d. Practical considerations

John 16:7-11-_But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the ^[c]Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you. ⁸ And He, when He comes, will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment; ⁹ concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me; ¹⁰ and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no longer see Me; ¹¹ and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.

The website "<u>Middle East Facts</u>" puts things into proper perspective when it says:

"Unlike Islam's *Koran*, which commands Muslims to force the entire planet to submit to literal control by Islam, the Jewish

Torah promises the children of Israel a modest and reasonable allotment of land. Israel...is a democratic nation 1/19th the size of California, surrounded by 22 hostile Arab/Islamic dictatorships with 640 times her size, 60 times her population and ALL the oil. How dare Arab propagandists call Israel "expansionist!" And how dare anyone believe them! How can Israel, which occupies one-sixth of one percent of the lands called Arab, be responsible for the political dissatisfaction of 22 Arab countries? Canadian lawyer Jacques Paul <u>Gauthier</u> recently finished a twenty-year project in which this Gentile Christian researched at the University of Geneva political science department and international law school, the legal issues relating to the ownership of Israel and Jerusalem. Gauthier's PhD thesis was completed in 2007.

For example, in 1867, <u>Mark Twain</u> visited Israel. He wrote about his experiences in his book *Innocents Abroad*. In this book, he

hardly describes the vibrant and prosperous Israel of today, but rather a desolate country that was devoid of both vegetation and human population. He observed:

"..... A desolate country whose soil is rich enough, but is given over wholly to weeds... a silent mournful expanse.... a desolation is here that not even imagination can grace with the pomp of life and action.... we never saw a human being on the whole route.... there was hardly a tree or shrub anywhere. Even the olive tree and the cactus, those fast friends of a worthless soil, had almost deserted the country."
