
Exodus 3:1-10 (NASB95)


1 Now Moses was pasturing the flock of Jethro his father-inlaw, the priest of Midian; and he led the flock to the west side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. ² The angel of the LORD appeared to him in a blazing fire from the midst of a bush; and he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, yet the bush was not consumed. ³ So Moses said, "I must turn aside now and see this marvelous sight, why the bush is not burned up." 4 When the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am."

Exodus 3:1-10 (NASB95)

5 Then He said, "Do not come near here; remove your sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground." 6 He said also, "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." Then Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God. ⁷ The LORD said, "I have surely seen the affliction of My people who are in Egypt, and have given heed to their cry because of their taskmasters, for I am aware of their sufferings. 8 "So I have come down to deliver them from the power of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and spacious land, to a land flowing with milk...

Exodus 3:1–10 (NASB95) ...and honey, to the place of the Canaanite and the Hittite and the Amorite and the Perizzite and the Hivite and the Jebusite. ⁹ "Now, behold, the cry of the sons of Israel has come to Me; furthermore, I have seen the oppression with which the Egyptians are oppressing them. ¹⁰ "Therefore, come now, and I will send you to Pharaoh, so that you may bring My people, the sons of Israel, out of Egypt."

"The Angel of the Lord"




- As in this account, many who saw the angel of the Lord said that God had spoken and that they had seen God.
- Appearances of the angel of the Lord ceased at Christ's birth, so we take Him to be the Pre-Incarnate, Son of God.





 So the angel of the Lord appears to Moses as a burning bush that never burns up.












Hebrews 7:19 (NASB95) (for the Law made nothing perfect), and on the other hand there is a bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God.






Exodus 3:14-16 (NASB95)


¹⁴ God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"*; and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM* has sent me to you.'" ¹⁵ God, furthermore, said to Moses, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'The Lord, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.' This is My name forever, and this is My memorial-name to all generations. ¹⁶ Go and gather the elders of Israel together and say to them, 'The Lord, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, has appeared to me, saying, "I am indeed concerned about you and what has been done to you in Egypt."





John 18:4-8 (NASB95)


