 - ◆ Daniel served through 2 gentile empires and 4 successive gentile administrations

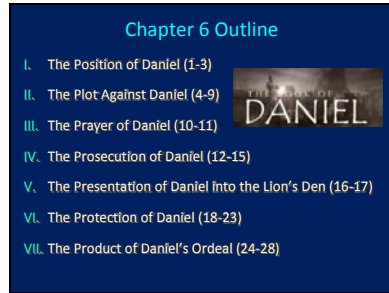

Rev. 9:20-The rest of ^[r]mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, so as not to worship demons, and the idols of gold and of silver and of brass and of stone and of wood, **which can neither see nor hear nor walk**

Luke 24:5-and as *the women* were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, *the men* said to them, “Why do you seek the living One among the dead?”

Dan. 3:25-He said, “Look! I see four men loosed *and* walking *about* in the midst of the fire ^[v]without harm, and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of *the* gods!”

Do you believe this?”²⁷ She *said to Him, “Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are ^[f]the Christ, the Son of God, *even* ^[g]He who comes into the world.”

Num. 6:24-26- The LORD bless you, and keep you;²⁵ The LORD make His face shine on you, And be gracious to you;²⁶ The LORD lift up His countenance on you, And give you peace.’
