All three of these ancient nations currently comprise the single modern kingdom of Jordan. The city of Bozrah in Mount Seir is located in ancient Edom or southern Jordan. Since this area will escape the domination of the Antichrist, it is logical for the Jews to flee to this place. Thus, God will provide a city of refuge outside the Antichrist's domain for the fleeing Remnant. It will be a very defensible city located in Mount Seir...Furthermore, as they flee and while they are living there, food and water will be miraculously provided."





No other place qualifies as the 'Holy Mountain' but the Temple Mount in Jerusalem. The 'royal pavilion' in Daniel 11:45 refers to the military command center of the Antichrist in Jerusalem. Why in Jerusalem? Because apparently he will already be there, it is for this reason that the attack by the other kings will be aimed at Jerusalem (Daniel 11:44) and why the Antichrist will be killed there..."



Matt. 24:6- You will be hearing of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not frightened, for *those things* must take place, but *that* is not yet the end.

1 Tim. 6:9-10-9 But those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction. ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Josephus defines *Cush* as Ethiopia, explaining, "For of the four sons of <u>Ham</u>, time has not at all hurt the name of <u>Cush</u>; for the <u>Ethiopians</u>, over whom he reigned, are even at this day, both by themselves and by all men in Asia, called <u>Cushites</u>." Josephus, *Antiquities*, 1.6.2.

In fact, in Ezekiel 38:5, the New American Standard Bible uses the word "Ethiopia" as a translation of the Hebrew word "Cush."

The *Ryrie Study Bible* indicates that the ancient country of Ethiopia encompassed far more territory than the modern country of Ethiopia, since the ancient country of Ethiopia included the northern Sudan. Charles C. Ryrie, *Ryrie Study Bible: New American Standard Bible* (Chicago: Moody, 1995), p. 1,021.

The Wycliffe Bible Encyclopedia states under the entry "Cush": "The designation, Ethiopia, is misleading for it did not refer to the modern state of Ethiopia...Cush...bordered Egypt on the S[outh],...or modern Sudan." Thus, Cush is most likely modern-day Sudan. Philip C. Johnson, "Cush," in Wycliffe Bible Encyclopedia, ed. Howard F. Vos, Charles F. Pfeiffer, John Rea (Chicago: Moody, 1975), p. 1.411.

Ezek. 38:15-You will come from your place out of the remote parts of the **north**, you and many peoples with you, all of them riding on horses, a great assembly and a mighty army

Isaiah 46:1-4-Bel has bowed down, Nebo stoops over; Their images are *consigned* to the beasts and the cattle. <u>The things</u> that you carry are burdensome, A load for the weary

<u>beast</u>.² They stooped over, they have bowed down together; They could not rescue the burden, But have themselves gone into captivity.³ "Listen to Me, O house of Jacob, And all the remnant of the house of Israel, <u>You who have been borne by Me from birth And have been carried from the womb; Even to your old age I will be the same, And even to your graying years I will bear you! I have done it, and I will carry you; And I will bear you and I will deliver you.</u>

Prov. 24:16-For a righteous man falls seven times, and rises again, But the wicked stumble in *time of* calamity.
