"The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the LORD turn his face toward you and give you peace." (NIV)

Matt. 27:50-And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and **yielded up His spirit**.

Acts 7:59-59 They went on stoning Stephen as he called on *the Lord* and said, "Lord Jesus, <u>receive my spirit</u>!"

Job 9:25-27-"As for me, I know that my Redeemer lives, And at the last He will take His stand on the earth.²⁶ "Even after my skin is destroyed, Yet from my flesh I shall see God;²⁷ Whom I myself shall behold, And whom my eyes will see and not another. My heart faints within me!

Isa. 26:19-Your dead will live; Their corpses will rise. You who lie in the dust, awake and shout for joy, For your dew is as the dew of the dawn, And the earth will give birth to the departed spirits.

John 5:29-²⁹ and will come forth; those who did the good *deeds* to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil *deeds* to a resurrection of judgment.

John 11:23-24-²³ Jesus *said to her, "Your brother will rise again." ²⁴ Martha *said to Him, "I know that <u>he will rise again</u> in the resurrection on the last day."

Acts 24:15-15 having a hope in God, which these men cherish themselves, that <u>there shall certainly be a resurrection of both</u> <u>the righteous and the wicked</u>.

not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. ⁵ The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection.

Ecclesiastes 3:11-He has made everything ^[b]appropriate in its time. He has also set <u>eternity in their heart</u>, ^[c]yet so that man will not find out the work which God has done from the beginning even to the end.

Gen. 1:27-God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

PS. 90:2-Before the mountains were born [9]Or You gave birth to the earth and the world, Even from everlasting to everlasting, You are God.

Rom. 16:26-but now is manifested, and by the Scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the eternal God, has been made known to all the nations, *leading* to obedience of faith.

Rev. 14:11-And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever; they have no rest day and night, those who worship the beast and his image, and [h]whoever receives the mark of his name.

Rev. 19:20-²⁰ And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who performed the signs [h]in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and

those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with [i]brimstone.

Rev. 20:10-And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and ^[f]brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Rev. 4:10-the twenty-four elders will fall down before Him who sits on the throne, and will worship Him who lives **forever and ever**, and will cast their crowns before the throne, saying.

Rev. 11:15-The kingdom of the world has become *the kingdom* of our Lord and of His [i]Christ; and He will reign **forever and ever**."

Rev. 4:9-And when the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, to Him who lives forever and ever.

Matt. 18:8-"If your hand or your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off and throw it from you; it is better for you to enter life crippled or lame, than ^[f]to have two hands or two feet and be cast into the **eternal fire**.

Mark 9:43-If your hand causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life crippled, than, having your two hands, to go into [ac]hell, into the unquenchable fire.

Luke 16:19-31-¹⁹ "Now there was a rich man, and he habitually dressed in purple and fine linen, joyously living in splendor every day. ²⁰ And a poor man named Lazarus was laid at his gate, covered with sores, ²¹ and longing to be fed with the

crumbs which were falling from the rich man's table; besides, even the dogs were coming and licking his sores. ²² Now the poor man died and was carried away by the angels to Abraham's bosom; and the rich man also died and was buried. ²³ In Hades he lifted up his eyes, being in torment, and *saw Abraham far away and Lazarus in his bosom. 24 And he cried out and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus so that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool off my tongue, for I am in agony in this flame.' 25 But Abraham said, 'Child, remember that during your life you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus bad things; but now he is being comforted here, and you are in agony. ²⁶ And besides all this, between us and you there is a great chasm fixed, so that those who wish to come over from here to you will not be able, and that none may cross over from there to us.' 27 And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, that you send him to my father's house—²⁸ for I have five brothers in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.' 29 But Abraham *said, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.' 30 But he said, 'No, father Abraham, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent!' ³¹ But he said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead."

2 Cor. 5:8-we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be **absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord**.

Philip. 1:21-23-²¹ For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. ²² But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. ²³ But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for *that* is very much better.

Luke 16:19-31-19 "Now there was a rich man, and he habitually dressed in purple and fine linen, joyously living in splendor every day. ²⁰ And a poor man named **Lazarus** was laid at his gate, covered with sores, ²¹ and longing to be fed with the crumbs which were falling from the rich man's table; besides, even the dogs were coming and licking his sores. ²² Now the poor man died and was carried away by the angels to Abraham's bosom; and the rich man also died and was buried. ²³ In Hades he lifted up his eyes, being in torment, and *saw **Abraham** far away and **Lazarus** in his bosom. ²⁴ And he cried out and said, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus so that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool off my tongue, for I am in agony in this flame.' 25 But **Abraham** said, 'Child, remember that during your life you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus bad things; but now he is being comforted here, and you are in agony. ²⁶ And besides all this, between us and you there is a great chasm fixed, so that those who wish to come over from here to you will not be able, and that none may cross over from there to us.' 27 And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, that you send him to my

father's house—²⁸ for I have five brothers—in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.' ²⁹ But <u>Abraham</u> *said, 'They have <u>Moses and the Prophets</u>; let them hear them.' ³⁰ But he said, 'No, father <u>Abraham</u>, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent!' ³¹ But he said to him, 'If they do not listen to <u>Moses and the Prophets</u>, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead."'

2 Cor. 12:4-4 was caught up into **Paradise** and heard inexpressible words, which a man is not permitted to speak.

Rev. 20:13-¹³ And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one *of them* according to their deeds.
