

“The understanding of prophecy peculiarly requires spiritual insight and the teaching of the Holy Spirit. Even though the Scriptures describe in great detail the time of the end, it is obvious that the wicked will not avail themselves of this divine revelation; but it will be a source of comfort and direction to those who are true believers in God. Divine revelation is often given in such a way that it is hid to the wicked even though it is understandable by those spiritually minded.”

1 John 1:7-but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Rom. 11:26-and so all Israel will be saved

Zech. 12:10-"I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication, so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn.

Rev. 7:9, 13-14- After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could count, from every nation and *all* tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, and palm branches *were* in their hands... ¹³ Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "These who are clothed in the white robes, who are they, and where have they come from?" ¹⁴ I ^[a]said to him, "My lord, you know." And he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Rev. 9:20-21- The rest of ^[r]mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, so as not to worship demons, and the idols of gold and of silver and of brass and of stone and of wood, which can neither see nor hear

nor walk; ²¹ and they did not repent of their murders nor of their sorceries nor of their immorality nor of their thefts.

Rev. 16:9- Men were scorched with ^[g]fierce heat; and they blasphemed the name of God who has the power over these plagues, and they did not repent so as to give Him glory.

Rev. 16:11- and they blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores; and they did not repent of their deeds.

Rev. 16:21- And huge ^[n]hailstones, about ^[o]one hundred pounds each, *came down from heaven upon men; and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, because its plague *was extremely ^[p]severe.

Rev. 6:15- Then the kings of the earth and the great men and the ^[m]commanders and the rich and the strong and every slave and free man hid themselves in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains.

Rev. 19:19-And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies assembled to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.

Heb. 3:7-8, 12-13- Therefore, just as the Holy Spirit says, "TODAY IF YOU HEAR HIS VOICE, ⁸ DO NOT HARDEN YOUR HEARTS AS ^[b]WHEN THEY PROVOKED ME, AS IN THE DAY OF TRIAL IN THE WILDERNESS... ² Take care, brethren, that there not be in any one of you an evil, unbelieving heart ^[c]that falls away from the living God. ¹³ But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is *still* called "Today," so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

Rom. 1:18, 21-22- ¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth ^[i]in unrighteousness... ²¹ For even though they knew God, they did not ^[n]honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. ²² Professing to be wise, they became fools.

2 Tim. 3:7- always learning and never able to come to the ^[e]knowledge of the truth.

Ps. 14:1-The fool has said in his heart, “There is no God.”

2 Pet. 3:5 (NKJV)-For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water

Prov. 1:7-The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge.

Rev. 16:18-20- ¹⁸ And there were noises and thunderings and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on the earth. ¹⁹ Now the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And great Babylon was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath. ²⁰ Then every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

2 Chronicles 30:2-4- ² For the king and his leaders and all the assembly in Jerusalem had agreed to keep the Passover in the second month. ³ For they could not keep it at the regular time, ^[a] because a sufficient number of priests had not consecrated themselves, nor had the people gathered together at

Jerusalem. ⁴ And the matter pleased the king and all the assembly.

1 Cor. 6:19-20- ¹⁹ Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit *who is* in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? ²⁰ For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body^[c] and in your spirit, which are God's.

Rev. 19:20-Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Matt. 25:34-Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

Luke 19:17, 19-And he said to him, 'Well *done*, good servant; because you were faithful in a very little, have authority over ten cities.'... Likewise he said to him, 'You also be over five cities.'
