John 13:23- There was reclining on Jesus' bosom one of His disciples, whom Jesus loved.

Isa. 6:3-³ And one called out to another and said, "Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts, The ^[a]whole earth is full of His glory."

Isa. 6:5-⁵ Then I said, "Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of **unclean lips**, And I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts."

Gen. 3:8- They heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the ^[c]cool of the day, and the man and **his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God** among the trees of the garden.

Luke 5:8- But when Simon Peter saw *that*, he fell down at Jesus' ^[c]feet, saying, "Go away from me Lord, for I am a sinful man!"

Rom. 3:11- THERE IS NONE WHO UNDERSTANDS, THERE IS NONE WHO SEEKS FOR GOD.

Philip. 3:9-and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from *the* Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which *comes* from God on the basis of faith.

Eph. 1:20-which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His **right hand** in the heavenly *places*

Matt. 25:33-and He will put the sheep on His **right**, and the goats on the left.

Dan. 10:11- He said to me, “O Daniel, **man of ^[m]high esteem**, understand the words that I am about to tell you and stand ^[u]upright, for I have now been sent to you.” And when he had spoken this word to me, I stood up trembling.

Dan. 10:19- He said, “O **man of ^[t]high esteem**, do not be afraid. Peace ^[u]be with you; take courage and be courageous!” Now as soon as he spoke to me, I received strength and said, “May my lord speak, for you have strengthened me.”

Philip. 4:6-7- ⁶Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which surpasses all ^[d]comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Rev. 21:8- But for the cowardly and ^[d]unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part *will be* in the lake that burns with fire and ^[e]brimstone, which is the second death.

Prov. 28:1- The wicked flee when no one is pursuing, But the righteous are ^[a]bold as a lion.

John 1:3-All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

Col. 1:16-For ^[x]**by Him all things were created**, *both* in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him.

Heb. 1:2-in these last days has spoken to us ^[b]in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, **through whom also He made the ^[c]world.**

Rev. 5:6-And I saw ^[g]between the throne (with the four living creatures) and the elders **a Lamb standing, as if slain**, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth.

Rev. 5:9-And they *sang a new song, saying, “Worthy are You to take the ^[i]book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and **purchased for God with Your blood** *men* from every tribe and tongue and people and nation.”

Col. 1:17-He ^[y]is before all things, and **in Him all things ^[z]hold together.**

Rev. 17:14-These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because **He is Lord of lords and King of kings**, and those who are with Him *are the* called and chosen and faithful.

Rev. 19:16-And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, “**KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.**”

Heb. 2:15-and might free those who through **fear of death** were subject to slavery all their lives.

2 Cor. 5:8- we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.

Philip. 1:21-23- ²¹ For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. ²² ^[s] But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know ^[t] which to choose. ²³ But I am

hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for *that* is very much better.

Luke 16:23-In **Hades** he lifted up his eyes, being in torment, and *saw Abraham far away and Lazarus in his bosom.

Rev. 20:14-Then death and **Hades** were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire.

Rev. 2:1-To the **angel** of the church in Ephesus write...

Matthew 11:10-This is the one about whom it ^[k]is written, 'BEHOLD, I SEND MY **MESSENGER** ^[l]AHEAD OF YOU, WHO WILL PREPARE YOUR WAY BEFORE YOU.'

Luke 9:52-and He sent **messengers** on ahead of Him, and they went and entered a village of the Samaritans to ^[af]make arrangements for Him.

Jas. 2:25-In the same way, was not Rahab the harlot also justified by works when she received the **messengers** and sent them out by another way?

Eph. 1:20-which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His **right hand** in the heavenly *places*

Matt. 25:33-and He will put the sheep on His **right**, and the goats on the left.

Matt. 5:39-But I say to you, do not resist an evil person; but whoever slaps you on your **right** cheek, turn the other to him also.

1 Tim. 5:17-The elders who rule well are to be considered worthy of **double honor**, especially those who work hard ^[e]at preaching and teaching.

Rev. 4:5-Out from the throne come flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder. And *there were* **seven lamps** of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.
