Conclusion

1 Tim. 2:11-14- ¹¹ A woman must quietly receive instruction with entire submissiveness. ¹² But I do not allow a woman to teach or exercise authority over a man, but to remain

quiet. ¹³ For it was Adam who was first ^[h]created, *and* then Eve. ¹⁴ *And it was not Adam who* was deceived, but the woman being deceived, ^[i]fell into transgression.

Acts 16:14-**A woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple fabrics,** a worshiper of God, was listening; ^[f]and the Lord opened her heart to respond to the things spoken by Paul.

2 Tim. 1:5- For I am mindful of the sincere faith within you, which first dwelt in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am sure that *it is* in you as well.

2 Tim. 3:15-and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Titus 2:3-4--³ **Older women** likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips nor enslaved to much wine, **teaching what is good,** ⁴ **so that they may** ^[b]**encourage the young women** to love their husbands, to love their children.

Rev. 1:1- The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His bond-servants, the things which must soon take place; and He sent and ^[a]communicated *it* by His angel to His bond-servant John.

Exod. 34:15-otherwise you might make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land and they would play the harlot with their gods and sacrifice to their gods, and someone might invite you ^[m]to eat of his sacrifice.

Gen. 6:3-Then the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not ^[b]strive with man forever, ^[c]because he also is flesh; ^[d]nevertheless his days shall be **one hundred and twenty years.**”

1 Peter 3:20—who once were disobedient, **when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah**, during the construction of the ark, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through *the* water.

Gen. 9:6- Whoever sheds man’s blood, By man his blood shall be shed, **For in the image of God He made man.**

Jas. 3:9-With it we bless *our* Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, **who have been made in the likeness of God.**

John 5:5-6-⁵ A man was there who had been ^[d]ill for thirty-eight years. ⁶ When Jesus saw him lying *there*, and knew that he had already been a long time *in that condition*, He *said to him, “Do you wish to get well?”

1 Kings 18:27 (CEV)-At noon, Elijah began making fun of them. “Pray louder!” he said. “Baal must be a god. Maybe he’s day-dreaming or **using the toilet** or traveling somewhere. Or maybe he’s asleep, and you have to wake him up.”

1 Cor. 11:30-For this reason many among you are weak and **sick**, and a number sleep.

Hosea 9:1- Do not rejoice, O Israel, ^[a]with exultation like the nations! For you have **played the harlot**, ^[c]forsaking your God.

James 4:4- You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

Rev. 17:1-Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and spoke with me, saying, “Come here, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot who sits on many waters.

Matt. 24:21-22--²¹ For then there will be a great tribulation, such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever will. ²² Unless those days had been cut short, no ^[i]life would have been saved; but for the sake of the ^[k]elect those days will be cut short.

Rev. 7:14-I ^[a]said to him, “My lord, you know.” And he said to me, “These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Rev. 3:10-Because you have kept the word of My ^[g]perseverance, I also will keep you from the hour of ^[h]testing, that *hour* which is about to come upon the whole ^[i]world, to ^[i]test those who dwell on the earth.

1 Cor. 11:30-For this reason many among you are weak and sick, and **a number sleep.**

John 8:44-**You are of your father the devil,** and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no

truth in him. Whenever he speaks ^[a]a lie, he speaks from his own *nature*, for he is a liar and the father of ^[o]lies.

Deut. 28:21-The LORD will make the **pestilence** cling to you until He has consumed you from the land where you are entering to possess it.

Ezek. 38:22-With **pestilence** and with blood I will enter into judgment with him; and I will rain on him and on his troops, and on the many peoples who are with him, ^[p]a torrential rain, with hailstones, fire and brimstone.

Acts 5:11-And great fear came over the whole church, and over all who heard of these things.

1 Tim. 4:1-But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will ^[a]fall away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and **doctrines of demons**.

1 Cor. 2:10-For to us God revealed *them* through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.

2 Cor. 11:13-15-¹³ For such men are false apostles, deceitful workers, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ. ¹⁴ No

wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. ¹⁵ Therefore it is not surprising if his servants also disguise themselves as servants of righteousness, whose end will be according to their deeds.
