





- 1. Apostle
- 2. Prophet
- 3. Worker of Miracles
- 4. Tongues
- 5. Interpretation of tongues
- 6. Healing
- 7. Knowledge



- 1. <u>Charismatics</u> All the spiritual gifts are in operation today
- **2.** <u>Cessationists</u> (selective) Most of the spiritual gifts are in operation today



### SLBC Position Statement No. 7

"TEMPORARY SPIRITUAL GIFTS — This church teaches that the miraculous sign gifts, including the gift of tongues, (always the ability to speak in a previously unlearned, known language) along with the gift of healings were temporal gifts, given by the Holy Spirit solely to authenticate both the apostles and their message before the close of the canon of Scripture (1 Cor. 13:8-10). We do not believe that these are active as gifts today. However, we affirm that God is sovereign and may heal and/or give someone the ability to speak in a tongue (foreign language) today. We believe that the majority of what is termed 'miraculous' within the contemporary charismatic movement is something other than the Biblical gifts of tongues or healing."

■ <u>Prophecy</u>: the ability to proclaim God's truth without compromise



■ <u>Teaching</u>: the ability to explain clearly what God has already revealed (1 Cor 12:28)

■ <u>Pastor-teacher</u>: the ability to equip and mature the body of Christ (Eph 4:11-16)

# Spiritual Gifts: #7 • Administration: the ability to effectively run or manage a church program

# Spiritual Gifts: #8 Leadership: the ability to cast an organizational vision and motivate others toward the fulfillment of that vision

■ <u>Knowledge</u>: the ability to understand complex biblical truths (1 Cor 8:1)



# Spiritual Gifts: #10

■ <u>Wisdom</u>: the ability to find knowledge from the Scriptures and apply it to daily life (1 Cor 2:6-7)



# Spiritual Gifts: #11

**Service**: the ability to minister to others



Spiritual Gifts: #12			
Giving: the ability to give material goods and financial resources with joy so that the needs of the Lord's work are met			

■ <u>Hospitality</u>: the ability to make guests feel comfortable and at home (Rom 12:13)



# Spiritual Gifts: #14

Mercy: the ability to devote energy toward helping those in pitiable conditions



■ <u>Helps</u>: the ability to free up others from certain responsibilities so that they can exercise their gifts more effectively (Acts 6:1-4)



# Spiritual Gifts: #16

■ <u>Faith</u>: the ability to trust God in the midst of life's difficulties


