Rom. 1:18-24-¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth ^[i]in unrighteousness, ¹⁹ because that which is known about God is evident ^[m]within them; for God made it evident to them. ²⁰ For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse. ²¹ For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. ²² Professing to be wise, they became fools, ²³ and exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures. ²⁴ Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them.

Ps. 14:1-**The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God."** They are corrupt, they have committed abominable [a]deeds; There is no one who does good."

Rev. 5:9-⁹ And they sang a new song, saying, "**Worthy are You** to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and **purchased for God with Your blood** *men* from every tribe and tongue and people and nation.

Rev. 5:12- saying with a loud voice, "**Worthy is the Lamb** that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing."
