### <u>11</u>

Wormwood. "Many species of wormwood (a woody herb) grow in Palestine, and all have a strong, bitter (but <u>not poisonous</u>) taste, which causes the plant to be used as a symbol of bitterness, sorrow, and calamity. This plague will make a third part of the fresh water supply of the earth unfit for human consumption."

#### <u>12</u>

Rev. 16:10-Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became darkened; and they gnawed their tongues because of pain.

"This could mean that the 24-hour cycle of day and night will be shortened to 16 hours or that the power of the sun, moon, and stars will be reduced by one-third."

Gen. 1:14-18-Then God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be for signs and for seasons and for days and years. <sup>15</sup> and let them be for [u]lights in the [y]expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth"; and it was so. <sup>16</sup> God made the two [w]great lights, the greater [x]light [y]to govern the day, and the lesser [z]light [aa]to govern the night; *He made* the stars also. <sup>17</sup> God placed them in the [ab]expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth, <sup>18</sup> and [ac]to govern the day and the night, and to separate the light from the darkness; and God saw that it was good.

Gen. 1:3-Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

Rev. 21:23-And the city has no need of the sun or of the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp *is* the Lamb.

Rev. 22:5-And there will no longer be *any* night; and they <sup>[d]</sup>will not have need of the light of a lamp nor the light of the sun, because the Lord God will illumine them; and they will reign forever and ever.

Job 38:7- When the morning **stars** sang together And all the sons of God shouted for joy?

Isa. 14:12- How you have fallen from heaven, O [g]star of the morning, son of the dawn! You have been cut down to the earth, You who have weakened the nations!

Rev. 12:4- And his tail \*swept away a third of the <u>stars</u> of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she gave birth he might devour her child.

Rev. 20:1-Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding the key of the **abyss** and a great chain [a]in his hand.

- 1 Pet. 3:19-20--<sup>19</sup> in <sup>[o]</sup> which also He went and made proclamation to the spirits *now* in prison, <sup>20</sup> who once were disobedient, when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah, during the construction of the ark, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through *the* <sup>[p]</sup> water.
- 2 Pet. 2:4-5-<sup>4</sup> For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment;<sup>5</sup> and did not spare the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a [a] preacher of righteousness, with seven others, when He brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly
- Jude 6-7- <sup>6</sup> And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode, He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgment of the great day, <sup>7</sup> just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the cities around them, since they in the same way as these indulged in gross immorality and went after <sup>[g]</sup>strange flesh, are exhibited as an <sup>[h]</sup>example in undergoing the punishment of eternal fire.
- Gen. 6:1-4-Now it came about, when men began to multiply on the face of the land, and daughters were born to them, <sup>2</sup> that the sons of God saw that the daughters of men were <sup>[a]</sup>beautiful; and they took wives for themselves, whomever they chose. <sup>3</sup> Then the LORD said, "My Spirit shall not <sup>[b]</sup>strive with man forever, <sup>[c]</sup>because he also is flesh; <sup>[d]</sup>nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years." <sup>4</sup> The Nephilim were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of men, and they bore *children* to them. Those were the mighty men who *were* of old, men of renown.

Eph. 1:13- In [9]Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also [1] believed, you were **sealed** in [8] Him with the Holy Spirit of promise.

Eph. 4:30- Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, [w] by whom you were <u>sealed</u> for the day of redemption.

Rev. 7:3-4-3 saying, "Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees until we have <u>sealed</u> the bond-servants of our God on their foreheads. And I heard the number of those who were <u>sealed</u>, one hundred and forty-four thousand sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel.

Ezek. 9:6- Utterly slay old men, young men, maidens, little children, and women, but do not touch any man on whom is the mark; and you shall start from My sanctuary." So they started with the [e]elders who *were* before the [f]temple.

John 7:6- So Jesus \*said to them, "My time is not yet here, but your time is always opportune."

1 Pet. 5:6- Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the **proper time**.

Rev. 6:8- I looked, and behold, an <sup>[i]</sup>ashen horse; and he who sat on it had the name Death; and Hades was following with him. Authority was given to them over <u>a fourth of the earth, to kill</u>

with sword and with famine and with [i]pestilence and by the wild beasts of the earth.

Joel 2:2-\_A day of darkness and gloom, A day of clouds and thick darkness. As the dawn is spread over the mountains, *So* there is a great and mighty people; <u>There has never been anything like it</u>, Nor will there be again after it To the years of many generations.

Dan. 12:1- Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands *guard* over the sons of your people, will arise. And there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time your people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued.

Jer. 30:7-\_'Alas! for that day is great, <u>There is none like it</u>; And it is the time of Jacob's distress, But he will be saved from it.

Matt. 24:21-22-<sup>21</sup> For then there will be <u>a great tribulation</u>, <u>such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now</u>, nor ever will. <sup>22</sup> Unless those days had been cut short, no <sup>[i]</sup> life would have been saved; but for the sake of the <sup>[k]</sup> elect those days will be cut short.

#### <u>16</u>

Rev. 5:11- Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders; and the number of them was **myriads of myriads, and thousands of thousands**.

#### **20-21**

Rev. 6:15-16--<sup>15</sup> Then the kings of the earth and the great men and the <sup>[m]</sup>commanders and the rich and the strong and every slave and free man <u>hid</u> themselves in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains; <sup>16</sup> and they \*said to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us and <u>hide</u> us from the <sup>[n]</sup>presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb.

Rev. 19:19- And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies assembled to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.

Isa. 46:1-4- Isa. 46:1-4-Bel has bowed down, Nebo stoops over; Their images are *consigned* to the beasts and the cattle. The things <sup>[a]</sup>that you carry are burdensome, A load for the weary *beast*. <sup>2</sup> They stooped over, they have bowed down together; They could not rescue the burden, But <sup>[b]</sup>have themselves gone into captivity. <sup>3</sup> "Listen to Me, O house of Jacob, And all the remnant of the house of Israel, You who have been borne by Me from <sup>[c]</sup>birth And have been carried from the womb; <sup>4</sup> Even to *your* old age I <sup>[d]</sup>will be the same, And even to *your* <sup>[c]</sup>graying years I will bear *you*! I have <sup>[f]</sup>done *it*, and I will carry *you*; And I will bear *you* and I will deliver *you*.

Gen. 4:10-He said, "What have you done? The voice of your brother's blood is crying to Me from the ground.

Gen. 2:24-For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother, and be joined to his wife; and they shall become one flesh.
