



Rev. 8:13-Then I looked, and I heard an eagle flying in midheaven, saying with a loud voice, “Woe, woe, woe to those who dwell on the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound!

Rev. 9:12-The first woe is past; behold, two woes are still coming after these things.

Rev. 10:7-but in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, then the mystery of God is finished, as He preached to His servants the prophets.

Dan. 7:14-And to Him was given dominion, Glory and a kingdom, That all the peoples, nations and *men of every* language Might serve Him. His dominion is an **everlasting** dominion Which will not pass away; And His kingdom is one Which will not be destroyed.

Dan. 7:26-27-²⁶ But the court will sit *for judgment*, and his dominion will be taken away, annihilated and destroyed forever. ²⁷ Then the sovereignty, the dominion and the greatness of *all* the kingdoms under the whole heaven will be given to the people of the saints of the Highest One; His kingdom *will be* an **everlasting** kingdom, and all the dominions will serve and obey Him.

Heb. 13:15-16-¹⁵ Through Him then, let us continually offer up **a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name.**

Ps. 2:1-6-**Why are the nations in an uproar** And the peoples devising a vain thing? ² The kings of the earth take their stand And **the rulers take counsel together Against the Lord and against His Anointed**, saying, ³ “Let us tear their fetters apart And cast away their cords from us!” ⁴ He who sits in the heavens laughs, The Lord scoffs at them. ⁵ Then He will speak to them in His anger And terrify them in His fury, saying, ⁶ “But as for Me, **I have installed My King Upon Zion, My holy mountain.**”

Prov. 1:7-The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Rom. 3:18-There is no fear of God before their eyes.

Rev. 20:12-13-¹² And I saw **the dead**, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. ¹³ And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, **every one of them according to their deeds.**

Luke 16:23-24-²³ In Hades he lifted up his eyes, being **in torment**, and saw Abraham far away and Lazarus in his bosom. ²⁴ And he cried out and said, ‘Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus so that he may dip the tip of his

finger in water and cool off my tongue, **for I am in agony in this flame.**'

Jude 7-just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the cities around them, since they in the same way as these indulged in gross immorality and went after strange flesh, are exhibited as an example in **undergoing the punishment of eternal fire.**

Rev. 6:10-11- ¹⁰ and they cried out with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" ¹¹ And there was given to each of them a white robe; and they were told that they should rest for a little while longer, until *the number of* their fellow servants and their brethren who were to be killed even as they had been, would be completed also.

Rev. 1:1- The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His **bond-servants**, the things which must soon take place; and He sent and communicated it by His angel to His bond-servant John.

Rev. 20:12-13-¹² And I saw the dead, **the great and the small**, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.

John 10:10- The thief comes only to steal and kill and **destroy**; I came that they may have life, and have *it* abundantly.

Gen. 3:17-19-¹⁷ Then to Adam He said, “Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, ‘You shall not eat from it’; Cursed is the ground because of you; In toil you will eat of it All the days of your life. ¹⁸“Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you; And you will eat the plants of the field; ¹⁹ By the sweat of your face You will eat bread...”

Rev. 20:2-3-² And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; ³ and he threw him into the abyss, and shut *it* and sealed *it* over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time.

Rev. 20:10-And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Heb. 8:5- who serve a copy and shadow of the heavenly things, just as Moses was warned *by God* when he was about to erect the tabernacle; for, “SEE,” He says, “THAT YOU MAKE all things ACCORDING TO THE PATTERN WHICH WAS SHOWN YOU ON THE MOUNTAIN.”

Matt. 6:10- Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.

Rev. 6:12- I looked when He broke the sixth seal, and there was a **great earthquake**; and the sun became black as sackcloth *made* of hair, and the whole moon became like blood.

Rev. 11:13- And in that hour there was a **great earthquake**, and a tenth of the city fell; seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and the rest were terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven.

Rev. 16:18-And there were flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder; and there was a **great earthquake**, such as there had not been since man came to be upon the earth, so great an earthquake *was it, and* so mighty.

Rev. 8:5-Then the angel took the censer and filled it with the fire of the altar, and threw it to the earth; and there followed peals of **thunder** and sounds and flashes of **lightning** and an **earthquake**.
