





#### Arnold Fruchtenbaum

"The name Bozrah means 'sheepfold.' An ancient sheepfold had a narrow entrance so that the shepherd could count his sheep. Once inside the fold, the sheep had more room to move around. Petra is shaped like a giant sheepfold, with its narrow passage opening up to a spacious circle surrounded by cliffs. This is not true of the town of Buseira. Furthermore, by modern Petra is a site known as Butzeira, which retains the Hebrew Botzrah...It will be a very defensible city located in Mount Seir...Furthermore, as they flee and while they are living there, food and water will be miraculously provided."





### <u>13</u>

Matt. 5:11-Blessed are you when *people* insult you and **persecute** you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me.

### <u>14</u>

Rev. 12:6-Then the woman fled into the <u>wilderness</u> where she \*had a place <u>prepared by God</u>, so that there she would be <u>nourished</u> for one thousand two hundred and sixty days.

- Rev. 12:14-But the two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, so that she could fly into the <u>wilderness</u> to her place, where she \*was <u>nourished</u> for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent.

- Matt. 4:11- Then the devil \*left Him; and behold, angels came and began to minister to Him.
- Heb. 1:14- Are they not all ministering spirits, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation?
- Dan. 12:1-Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands guard over the sons of your people, will arise. And there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time your people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued.

1 Kgs. 17:2-7- The word of the LORD came to him, saying, <sup>3</sup> "Go away from here and turn eastward, and hide yourself by the brook Cherith, which is east of the Jordan. <sup>4</sup> It shall be that you will drink of the brook, and I have commanded the ravens to provide for you there." <sup>5</sup> So he went and did according to the word of the LORD, for he went and lived by the brook Cherith, which is east of the Jordan. <sup>6</sup> The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning and bread and meat in the evening, and he would drink from the brook. <sup>7</sup> It happened after a while that the brook dried up, because there was no rain in the land.

1 Kgs. 17:8-15-8 Then the word of the LORD came to him, saying, 9 "Arise, go to Zarephath, which belongs to Sidon, and stay there; behold, I have commanded a widow there to provide for you." <sup>10</sup> So he arose and went to Zarephath, and when he came to the gate of the city, behold, a widow was there gathering sticks; and he called to her and said, "Please get me a little water in a jar, that I may drink." 11 As she was going to get it, he called to her and said, "Please bring me a piece of bread in your hand."12 But she said, "As the LORD your God lives, I have no bread, only a handful of flour in the bowl and a little oil in the jar; and behold, I am gathering a few sticks that I may go in and prepare for me and my son, that we may eat it and die." <sup>13</sup> Then Elijah said to her, "Do not fear; go, do as you have said, but make me a little bread cake from it first and bring it out to me, and afterward you may make one for yourself and for your son. <sup>14</sup> For thus says the LORD God of Israel, 'The bowl of flour shall not be exhausted, nor shall the jar of oil be empty, until the day that the LORD sends rain on the face of the earth." <sup>15</sup> So she went and did according to the word of Elijah, and she and he and her household ate for *many* days.

Luke 4:26-29-<sup>26</sup> and yet Elijah was sent to none of them, but only to Zarephath, *in the land* of Sidon, to a woman who was a widow. <sup>27</sup> And there were many lepers in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet; and none of them was cleansed, but only Naaman the Syrian." <sup>28</sup> And all *the people* in the synagogue were filled with rage as they heard these things; <sup>29</sup> and they got up and drove Him out of the city, and led Him to the brow of the hill on which their city had been built, in order to throw Him down the cliff.

Matt. 25:37-40-<sup>37</sup> Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry, and feed You, or thirsty, and give You *something* to drink? <sup>38</sup> And when did we see You a stranger, and invite You in, or naked, and clothe You? When did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You? <sup>40</sup> The King will answer and say to them, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did it to one of these brothers of Mine, *even* the least *of them*, you did it to Me.'

Rev. 12:6-Then the woman fled into the wilderness where she \*had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished for <u>one thousand two hundred and sixty days</u>.
