



"Another plausible explanation is that the final world ruler receives a wound which normally would be fatal but is miraculously healed by Satan. While the resurrection of a dead person seems to be beyond Satan's power, the healing of a wound would be possible for Satan, and this may be the explanation. "Another suggestion is the city now known as <u>Petra</u>...this author prefers the identification with <u>Petra</u>. <u>Petra</u> is located in a basin within Mount Seir, and is totally surrounded by mountains and cliffs. The only way in and out of the city is through a narrow passageway that extends for about a mile and can only be negotiated by foot or by horseback. This makes the city easy to defend, and its surrounding high cliffs give added meaning and confirmation to Isaiah 33.16. Only a few abreast can enter through this passage at any one time, giving this city even greater defensibility."

"The name Bozroh means 'sheepfold.' An ancient sheepfold had a narrow entrance so that the shepherd could count his sheep. Once inside the fold, the sheep had more room to move around. Petro is shaped like a giant sheepfold, with its narrow passage opening up to a spacious circle surrounded by cliffs. This is not true of the town of Buseira. Furthermore, by modern Petro is a site known as Butzeira, which retains the Hebrew Botzrah. Lit will be a very defensible city located in Mount Seir...Furthermore, as they flee and while they are living there, food and water will be miraculously provided."

Exod. 8:6-7-6 So Aaron stretched out his hand over the waters of Egypt, and the frogs came up and covered the land of

Egypt. ⁷ The magicians did the same with their secret arts, making frogs come up on the land of Egypt.

Exod. 8:17-19-¹⁷ They did so; and Aaron stretched out his hand with his staff, and struck the dust of the earth, and there were gnats on man and beast. All the dust of the earth became gnats through all the land of Egypt. ¹⁸ The magicians tried with their secret arts to bring forth gnats, but they could not; so there were gnats on man and beast. ¹⁹ Then the magicians said to Pharaoh, "This is the finger of God." But Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he did not listen to them, as the LORD had said.

Rev. 20:4-5-⁴ Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and <u>they came to life</u> and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. ⁵ The rest of the dead did not <u>come to life</u> until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection.

1 Sam. 16:7-But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at the height of his stature, because I have rejected

him; for God sees not as man sees, for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."

Dan. 7:8-While I was contemplating the horns, behold, another horn, a little one, came up among them, and three of the first horns were pulled out by the roots before it; and behold, this horn possessed eyes like the eyes of a man and <u>a mouth</u> <u>uttering great boasts</u>.

Dan. 7:11-Then I kept looking because of the sound of **the boastful words** which the horn was speaking; I kept looking until the beast was slain, and its body was destroyed and given to the burning fire.

Dan. 7:20-and *the meaning* of the ten horns that *were* on its head and the other *horn* which came up, and before which three *of them* fell, namely, that horn which had eyes and <u>a mouth</u> <u>uttering great *boasts*</u> and which was larger in appearance than its associates.

Dan. 7:25-<u>He will speak out against the Most High</u> and wear down the saints of the Highest One, and he will intend to make alterations in times and in law; and they will be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time.

Matt. 12:34-You brood of vipers, how can you, being evil, speak what is good? For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart.

Matt. 12:36- But I tell you that every careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment.

Rev. 11:2-Leave out the court which is outside the temple and do not measure it, for it has been given to the nations; and they will tread under foot the holy city for **forty-two months**.

Rev. 11:3-And I will grant *authority* to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for <u>twelve hundred and sixty days</u>, clothed in sackcloth."

Rev. 12:6-Then the woman fled into the wilderness where she

had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished for <u>one thousand two hundred and sixty days</u>.

Rev. 12:14-But the two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, so that she could fly into the wilderness to her place, where she was nourished for a time and <u>times and half a time</u>, from the presence of the serpent.

Rev. 7:11-And all the <u>angels</u> were standing around the throne and around <u>the elders</u> and <u>the four living creatures</u>; and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God

Rev. 1:20-As for the mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and <u>the</u> <u>seven lampstands are the seven churches</u>.

Rev. 4:5-Out from the throne come flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder. And *there were* **seven lamps of fire burning before the throne,** which are the seven Spirits of God.

Dan. 7:21-I kept looking, and that horn was waging war with the **saints** and **overpowering them**.
