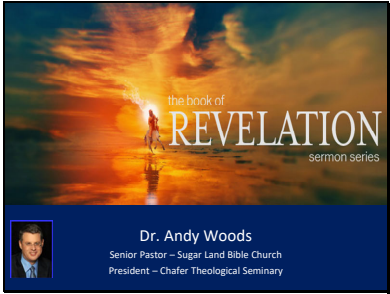
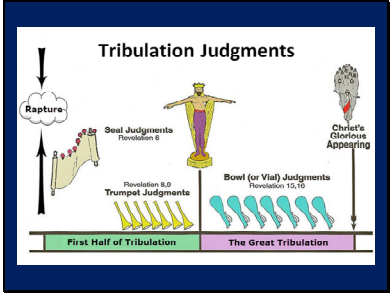

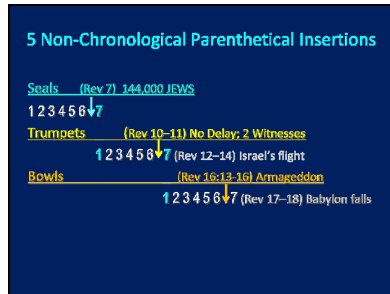

- 7. **7th Trumpet (11:14-19) – Legal transfer announced**

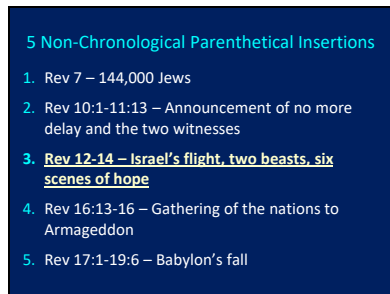



Tribulation Judgments



The diagram illustrates the sequence of events during the Tribulation. It is divided into two main periods: the First Half of Tribulation and The Great Tribulation. The Rapture occurs at the beginning. The Seal Judgments (Revelation 6) occur during the First Half. The Trumpet Judgments (Revelation 8,9) occur during the Great Tribulation. The Bowl (or Vial) Judgments (Revelation 15,16) occur at the end of the Great Tribulation, leading to Christ's Glorious Appearing.



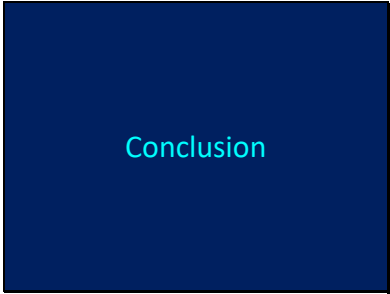

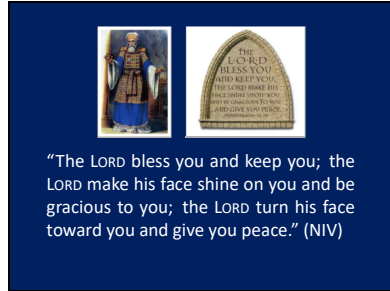

Rev. 10:7-but in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, then the mystery of God is **finished**, as He preached to His servants the prophets.

Rev. 8:13-Then I looked, and I heard an eagle flying in midheaven, saying with a loud voice, “**Woe, woe, woe** to those who dwell on the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound!”

Rev. 9:12-The first woe is past; behold, **two woes** are still coming after these things.

Rev. 14:13-And I heard a voice from heaven, saying, “Write, ‘Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on!’” “Yes,” says the Spirit, “so that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow with them.”

Rev. 20:4-Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I *saw* the souls of those

who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

2 Cor. 5:8- we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.

Philip. 1:21-23-²¹ For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. ²² But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. ²³ But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for *that* is very much better.

Heb. 2:15-and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives.

Rev. 13:15-And it was given to him to give breath to **the image of the beast**, so that the image of the beast would even speak and cause as many as do not worship the image of the beast to be killed.

Rev. 13:16-18-¹⁶ And he causes all, the small and the great, and the rich and the poor, and the free men and the slaves, to be given a mark on their right hand or on their forehead, ¹⁷ and *he provides* that no one will be able to buy or to sell, except the one who has the mark, *either* the name of the beast or the number of his name. ¹⁸ Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for the **number** is that of a man; and his number is six hundred and sixty-six.

Rev. 7:13-14-¹³ Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, “These who are clothed in the white robes, who are they, and where have they come from?” ¹⁴ I said to him, “My lord, you know.” And he said to me, “These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Exod. 15:1-Then Moses and the sons of Israel sang this song to the LORD, and said, “I will sing to the LORD, for He is highly exalted; The horse and its rider He has hurled into the sea.

Deut. 32:4- The Rock! His work is perfect, For all His ways are just; A God of faithfulness and without injustice, Righteous and upright is He.

Deut. 31:29- For I know that after my death you will act corruptly and turn from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in **the latter days**, for you will do that which is evil in the sight of the LORD, provoking Him to anger with the work of your hands.

Deut. 31:21- Then it shall come about, when many evils and troubles have come upon them, that this song will testify before them as a witness (for it **shall not be forgotten** from the lips of their descendants); for I know their intent which they are developing today, before I have brought them into the land which I swore.

Matt. 26:30-After singing a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.

John 14:6-⁶ Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and **the truth**, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Heb. 6:18-so that by two unchangeable things in which it is **impossible for God to lie**, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.

Ps. 103:7-He made known His **ways** to Moses, His **acts** to the sons of Israel.

Prov. 1:7-The **fear of the LORD** is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Rom. 1:23-and exchanged **the glory** of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures.

Rev. 14:7-and he said with a loud voice, “**Fear God**, and **give Him glory**, because the hour of His judgment has come; **worship Him** who made the heaven and the earth and sea and springs of waters.

Acts 4:12-And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other **name** under heaven that has been given among men by which we **must** be saved.

Mark 10:18-And Jesus said to him, “Why do you call Me good? No one is good **except God alone**.”

Zech. 14:16-18-¹⁶ Then it will come about that any who are left of all the nations that went against Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to celebrate the Feast of Booths. ¹⁷ And it will be that whichever of the families of the earth does not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, there will be no rain on them. ¹⁸ If the family of Egypt does not go up or enter, then no *rain will fall* on them; it will be the plague with which the LORD smites the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.

Isa. 55:8-9- “For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways,” declares the LORD. ⁹ “For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways And My thoughts than your thoughts.

Heb. 8:5-who serve a copy and shadow of the heavenly things, just as Moses was warned *by God* when he was about to erect the tabernacle; for, “SEE,” He says, “THAT YOU MAKE all things ACCORDING TO THE PATTERN WHICH WAS SHOWN YOU ON THE MOUNTAIN.”

Gen. 19:15-When morning dawned, the angels urged Lot, saying, “Up, take your wife and your two daughters who are here, or you will be swept away in the punishment of the city.”

Gen. 19:22-Hurry, escape there, for I cannot do anything until you arrive there.” Therefore the name of the town was called Zoar.

Acts 12:22-23-²² The people kept crying out, “The voice of a god and not of a man!” ²³ And immediately an angel of the Lord struck him because he did not give God the glory, and he was eaten by worms and died.

Exod. 40:34-Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and **the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.**

Isa. 6:1-In the year of King Uzziah’s death **I saw the Lord** sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple.
