



Robert L. Thomas, Revelation 1-7: An Exegetical Commentary, and Youngh Barbes (Chinago Monde, 1993), 457-59.

Mankind in his rebellion correctly analyzes the cosmic and recrestrial disturbances as a part of the great end-time day of wrath rom the one sitting on the throne and from the Lamb. The verb letten (has come) is aorist indicative, referring to a previous privial of wrath, not something that is about to take place. Men see the arrival of this day at least as early as the cosmic upheavals that characterize the sixth seal (6:12-14), but upon reflection they probably recognize that it was already in effect with the death of one-fourth of the population (6:7-8), the worldwide famine (6:5-6), and the global warfare (6:3-4). The rapid sequence of all of these events could not escape notice, but the light of their true explanation does not dawn upon human consciousness until the evere phenomena of the sixth seal arrive."

- Tribulation = divine wrath (Rev 6:16-17; 11:18; 15:1, 7; 16:1, 19)







"As the angels emerge from the sanctuary, it is filled with smoke proceeding from the glory of God and His power, a pointed reminder of the ineffable holiness God. The scene can be compared to that when the cloud filled the Tabernacle in Exodus 40:34–35. Access into the sanctuary is made impossible by the smoke until the judgments contained in the seven plagues are fulfilled. It is an ominous sign of impending doom for those who persist in their blasphemous disregard of the sovereignty and holiness of God."

Exod. 32:15-Then Moses turned and went down from the mountain with the two <u>tablets of the testimony</u> in his hand, tablets which were written on both sides; they were written on one *side* and the other.

Acts 7:44-Our fathers had the <u>tabernacle of testimony</u> in the wilderness, just as He who spoke to Moses directed *him* to make it according to the pattern which he had seen.

Heb. 8:5-who serve **a copy and shadow of the heavenly things**, just as Moses was warned *by God* when he was about to

erect the tabernacle; for, "SEE," He says, "THAT YOU MAKE all things ACCORDING TO THE PATTERN WHICH WAS SHOWN YOU ON THE MOUNTAIN."

Gen. 19:15-When morning dawned, <u>the angels</u> urged Lot, saying, "Up, take your wife and your two daughters who are here, or you will be swept away in the punishment of the city."

Gen. 19:22-Hurry, escape there, for <u>I cannot do anything</u> until you arrive there." Therefore the name of the town was called Zoar.

Acts 12:22-23-<sup>22</sup> The people kept crying out, "The voice of a god and not of a man!" <sup>23</sup> And immediately <u>an angel of the</u>

Lord struck him because he did not give God the glory, and he was eaten by worms and died.

Rev. 19:8-It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright *and* clean; for the **fine linen** is the righteous acts of the saints.

Rev. 19:14-And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in <u>fine</u> linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses.

Rev. 1:13-and in the middle of the lampstands *I saw* one like a son of man, clothed in a robe reaching to the feet, and girded across His chest with **a golden sash**.

1 Kgs. 7:50-and the cups and the snuffers and the **bowls** and the spoons and the firepans, of pure gold; and the hinges both for the doors of the inner house, the most holy place, *and* for the doors of the house, *that is*, of the nave, **of gold**.

- Rev. 5:8-When He had taken the book, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each one holding a harp and **golden bowls full of incense**, which are the prayers of the saints.
- Jas. 5:16-Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.
- 1 Thess. 1:10-and to wait for His Son from [h]heaven, whom He raised from the dead, *that is* Jesus, **who rescues us from the** wrath to come.
- 1 Thess. 5:9-For <u>God has not destined us for wrath</u>, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ
- Rom 5:9-Much more then, having now been justified [e] by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.
- Rom. 8:1-Therefore there is now **no condemnation** for those who are in Christ Jesus.
- Luke 4:28-And all *the people* in the synagogue were <u>filled with</u> <u>rage</u> as they heard these things
- Rom. 2:5-But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are **storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath** and revelation of the righteous judgment of God
- Heb. 10:31-It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of **the living God**.
- Rev. 9:20-The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, so as not to worship demons, and the idols of gold and of silver and of

# brass and of stone and of wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk

Isa. 46:1-Bel has bowed down, Nebo stoops over; Their images are *consigned* to the beasts and the cattle. **The things that you carry are burdensome**, A load for the weary *beast*.

Isa. 46:4-Even to *your* old age I will be the same, And even to *your* graying years I will bear *you*! I have done *it*, and I will carry *you*; And I will bear *you* and I will deliver *you*.

Isa. 6:1-In the year of King Uzziah's death <u>I saw the Lord</u> sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, <u>with the train of His robe filling the temple</u>.

Isa. 6:4-And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while **the temple was filling with smoke**."

Exod. 40:34-Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

Exod. 19:18- Now Mount Sinai *was* all in smoke because the LORD descended upon it in fire; and its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked violently.

1 Kgs. 18:10-11-<sup>10</sup> It happened that when the priests came from the holy place, the cloud filled the house of the LORD, <sup>11</sup> so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for the glory of the LORD filled the house of the LORD.

2 Chron. 5:13-14-13 in unison when the trumpeters and the singers were to make themselves heard with one voice to praise and to glorify the LORD, and when they lifted up their

voice accompanied by trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and when they praised the LORD saying, "He indeed is good for His lovingkindness is everlasting," then the house, the house of the LORD, was filled with a cloud, <sup>14</sup> so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for the glory of the LORD filled the house of God.

Ezek. 11:23-23 The glory of the LORD went up from the midst of the city and stood over the mountain which is east of the city.

Ezek. 44:4-Then He brought me by way of the north gate to the front of the house; and I looked, and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house of the LORD, and I fell on my face.

Isa. 6:1-In the year of King Uzziah's death <u>I saw the Lord</u> sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple.

Isa. 6:5- Then I said, "<u>Woe is me, for I am ruined</u>! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.

Exod. 19:16- So it came about on the third day, when it was morning, that there were thunder and lightning flashes and a thick cloud upon the mountain and a very loud trumpet sound, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled.

Heb. 12:26- And <u>His voice shook the earth</u> then, but now He has promised, saying, "YET ONCE MORE I WILL SHAKE NOT ONLY THE EARTH, BUT ALSO THE HEAVEN."

John 1:1-In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:14- And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1:18- No one has seen God at any time; the only begotten God who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained *Him*.

Rev. 11:1-2-Then there was given me a measuring rod like a staff; and someone said, "Get up and measure <u>the temple</u> of God and the altar, and those who worship in it. <sup>2</sup> Leave out the court which is outside the temple and do not measure it, <u>for it has been given to the nations; and they will tread under foot the holy city for forty-two months</u>.

Acts 21:28-30-<sup>28</sup> crying out, "Men of Israel, come to our aid! This is the man who preaches to all men everywhere against our people and the Law and this place; and besides he has even brought Greeks into the temple and has defiled this holy place." <sup>29</sup> For they had previously seen Trophimus the Ephesian in the city with him, and they supposed that Paul had brought him into the temple. <sup>30</sup> Then all the city was provoked, and the people rushed together, and taking hold of Paul they dragged him out of the temple, and immediately the doors were shut.
