





Job 2:7-8-<sup>7</sup> Then Satan went out from the presence of the LORD and smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot to the crown of his head. <sup>8</sup> And he took a potsherd to scrape himself while he was sitting among the ashes.

Rev. 8:8-9-<sup>8</sup> The second angel sounded, and *something* like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea; and a third of the sea became blood,<sup>9</sup> and a third of the creatures which were in the sea and had life, died; and a third of the ships were destroyed.

Rev. 6:9-11-<sup>9</sup> When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God, and because of the testimony which they had maintained;<sup>10</sup> and they cried out with a loud voice, saying, “How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?”<sup>11</sup> And there was given to each of them a white robe; and they were told that they should rest for a little while longer, until *the number of* their fellow servants and their brethren who were to be killed even as they had been, would be completed also.

1 Kgs. 18:27 (CEV)- At noon, Elijah began making fun of them. “Pray louder!” he said. “Baal must be a god. Maybe he’s day-dreaming or **using the toilet** or traveling somewhere. Or maybe he’s asleep, and you have to wake him up.”

Matt. 23:24-You blind guides, who strain out a gnat and swallow a camel!

Exod. 1:22- Then Pharaoh commanded all his people, saying, “Every son who is born you are to cast into the Nile, and every daughter you are to keep alive.

Exod. 4:22- Then you shall say to Pharaoh, ‘Thus says the LORD, “Israel is My son, My firstborn.

Gen. 1:6-7-<sup>6</sup> Then God said, “Let there be an expanse in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters.”<sup>7</sup> God made the expanse, and separated the waters which were below the expanse from the waters which were above the expanse; and it was so.

Gen. 5:5- So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years, and he died.

Gen. 5:27- So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years, and he died.

2 Pet. 3:10- But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up.

2 Pet. 3:13-But according to His promise we are looking for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells.

Rev. 8:12- The fourth angel sounded, and a third of the sun and a third of the moon and a third of the stars were struck, so that a third of them would be darkened and the day would not shine for a third of it, and the night in the same way.

Isa. 30:26-The light of the moon will be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun will be seven times *brighter*, like the light of seven days, on the day the LORD binds up the fracture of His people and heals the bruise He has inflicted.

Gen. 1:3-Then God said, “Let there be light”; and there was light.

Gen. 1:14-19-<sup>14</sup> Then God said, “Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be for signs and for seasons and for days and years; <sup>15</sup> and let them be for lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth”; and it was so. <sup>16</sup> God made the two great lights, the greater light to govern the day, and the lesser light to govern the night; *He made* the stars also. <sup>17</sup> God placed them in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth, <sup>18</sup> and to govern the day and the night, and to separate the light from the darkness; and God saw that it was good. <sup>19</sup> There was evening and there was morning, a fourth day.

Deut. 4:19-And *beware* not to lift up your eyes to heaven and see the sun and the moon and the stars, all the host of heaven, and be drawn away and worship them and serve them, those which the LORD your God has allotted to all the peoples under the whole heaven.

Rev. 21:23-And the city has no need of the sun or of the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp *is* the Lamb.

Rev. 22:5-And there will no longer be *any* night; and they will not have need of the light of a lamp nor the light of the sun, because the Lord God will illumine them; and they will reign forever and ever.

Jer. 17:9- The heart is more deceitful than all else And is desperately sick; Who can understand it?

Exodus shows Pharaoh repeatedly hardening his own heart (7:13, 22; 8:15, 19, 32; 9:7). Not until the sixth plague did God harden Pharaoh’s heart (Exod 9:12).

Rev. 14:7- and he said with a loud voice, “Fear God, and give Him glory, because the hour of His judgment has come; worship Him who made the heaven and the earth and sea and springs of waters.”

Rev. 15:6-and the seven angels who had the seven plagues came out of the temple, clothed in linen, clean *and* bright, and girded around their chests with golden sashes.

Rom. 1:21-22- <sup>21</sup> For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. <sup>22</sup> Professing to be wise, they became fools.

Matt. 24:29-But immediately after the tribulation of those days THE SUN WILL BE DARKENED, AND THE MOON WILL NOT GIVE ITS LIGHT, AND THE STARS WILL FALL from the sky, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

Matt. 8:12-but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matt. 25:30-Throw out the worthless slave into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Exodus shows Pharaoh repeatedly hardening his own heart (7:13, 22; 8:15, 19, 32; 9:7). Not until the sixth plague did God harden Pharaoh’s heart (Exod. 9:12).

Gen. 2:8-The Lord God planted a garden toward the **east**, in Eden; and there He placed the man whom He had formed.

Gen. 11:2-It came about as they journeyed **east**, that they found a plain in the land of **Shinar** and settled there.

Matt. 2:2-Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we saw His star in the **east** and have come to worship Him.

Rev. 14:8-And another angel, a second one, followed, saying, “Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great, she who has made all the nations drink of the wine of the passion of her immorality.”
