





e Judgment Seat of Christ in Theological Perspect

"The judgment seat of Christ might be compared to a commencement ceremony. At graduation there is some measure of disappointment and remorse that one did not do better and work harder. However, at such an event the overwhelming emotion is joy, not remorse. The graduates do not leave the auditorium weeping because they did not earn better grades. Rather, they are thankful that they have been graduated, and they are grateful for what they did achieve. To overdo the sorrow aspect of the judgment seat of Christ is to make heaven hell. To under do the sorrow aspect is to make faithfulness inconsequential" (underlining mine).

And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed me these things. 9 But he said to me, "Do not do that. I am a fellow servant of yours and of your brethren the prophets and of those who heed the words of this book. Worship God."

Acts 14:11-18-11 When the crowds saw what Paul had done, they raised their voice, saying in the Lycaonian language, "The gods have become like men and have come down to us." 12 And they began calling Barnabas, Zeus, and Paul, Hermes, because he was the chief speaker. <sup>13</sup> The priest of Zeus, whose temple was just outside the city, brought oxen and garlands to the gates, and wanted to offer sacrifice with the crowds. <sup>14</sup> But when the apostles Barnabas and Paul heard of it, they tore their robes and rushed out into the crowd, crying out 15 and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We are also men of the same nature as you, and preach the gospel to you that you should turn from these vain things to a living God, WHO MADE THE HEAVEN AND THE EARTH AND THE SEA AND ALL THAT IS IN THEM. <sup>16</sup> In the generations gone by He permitted all the nations to go their own ways; <sup>17</sup> and yet He did not leave Himself without witness, in that He did good and gave you rains from heaven and fruitful seasons, satisfying your hearts with food and gladness." <sup>18</sup> Even saying these things, with difficulty they restrained the crowds from offering sacrifice to them.

1 Tim. 3:6- *and* not a new convert, so that he will not become conceited and fall into the condemnation incurred by the devil.

Prov. 16:18- Pride *goes* before destruction, And a haughty spirit before stumbling.

Isa. 42:8-I am the LORD, that is My name; I will not give My glory to another, Nor My praise to graven images.

## <u>11</u>

Acts 1:9-11-9 And after He had said these things, He was lifted up while they were looking on, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. <sup>10</sup> And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men in white clothing stood beside them. <sup>11</sup> They also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in just the same way as you have watched Him go into heaven."

Rev. 6:1-2-Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come." <sup>2</sup> I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.

Rev. 6:3-4-3 When He broke the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come." And another, a red horse, went out; and to him who sat on it, it was granted to take peace from the earth, and that *men* would slay one another; and a great sword was given to him.

2 Thess. 2:9 (NLT)- This man will come to do the work of Satan with **counterfeit** power and signs and miracles.

Zech. 9:9- Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout *in triumph*, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; He is just and endowed with salvation, Humble, and mounted on a **donkey**, **Even on a colt**, **the foal of a donkey**.

Matt. 2:1-6- When they had approached Jerusalem and had come to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, <sup>2</sup> saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied *there* and a colt with her; untie them and bring them to Me. <sup>3</sup> If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord has need of them,' and immediately he will send them." <sup>4</sup> This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet: <sup>5</sup> "SAY TO THE DAUGHTER OF ZION, 'BEHOLD YOUR KING IS COMING TO YOU, GENTLE, AND MOUNTED ON A DONKEY, EVEN ON A COLT, THE FOAL OF A BEAST OF BURDEN." <sup>6</sup> The disciples went and did just as Jesus had instructed them.

Rev. 12:17-So the dragon was enraged with the woman, and went off to make <u>war</u> with the rest of her children, who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus.

Luke 9:51-56-<sup>51</sup> When the days were approaching for His ascension, He was determined to go to Jerusalem; <sup>52</sup> and He sent messengers on ahead of Him, and they went and entered a village of the Samaritans to make arrangements for Him. <sup>53</sup> But they did not receive Him, because He was traveling toward Jerusalem. <sup>54</sup> When His disciples James and John saw *this*, they said, "Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them?" <sup>55</sup> But He turned and rebuked them, [and said, "You do not know what kind of spirit you are

of; <sup>56</sup> for the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them."] And they went on to another village.

Eccles. 3:1-There is an appointed time for everything. And there is a time for every event under heaven—

Eccles. 3:8-A time to love and a time to hate; A time for war and a time for peace.

### **12**

John 2:23-25-<sup>23</sup> Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name, observing His signs which He was doing. <sup>24</sup> But Jesus, on His part, was not entrusting Himself to them, for He knew all men, <sup>25</sup> and because He did not need anyone to testify concerning man, for He Himself knew what was in man.

Rev. 1:14-His head and His hair were white like white wool, like snow; and **His eyes were like a flame of fire**.

Rev. 2:17-He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, to him I will give *some* of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, and a new name written on the stone which no one knows but he who receives it.

Rev. 5:6-And I saw between the throne (with the four living creatures) and the elders a Lamb standing, <u>as if slain</u>, having

seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth.

John 20:27-28-<sup>27</sup> Then He \*said to Thomas, "Reach here with your finger, and see My hands; and reach here your hand and put it into My side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing." <sup>28</sup> Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"

1 Cor. 11:24- and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in **remembrance** of Me."

John 1:1- In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:14-And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Matt. 25:31-But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne.

Philip. 3:9-and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from *the* Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which *comes* from God on the basis of faith

Heb. 4:12-For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart. 2 Thess. 2:8-Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will **slay with the breath of His mouth** and bring to an end by the appearance of His coming.

Isa. 11:4-But with righteousness He will judge the poor, And decide with fairness for the afflicted of the earth; And He will **strike the earth with the rod of His mouth**, And with the breath of His lips He will slay the wicked.

Ps. 2:9- You shall break them with a rod of iron, You shall shatter them like earthenware.'

Matt. 27:27-30-<sup>27</sup> Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the Praetorium and gathered the whole *Roman* cohort around Him. <sup>28</sup> They stripped Him and put a scarlet robe on Him. <sup>29</sup> And after twisting together a **crown of thorns**, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand; and they knelt down before Him and mocked Him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" <sup>30</sup> They spat on Him, and took the reed and *began* to beat Him on the head.

## <u>17</u>

2 Cor. 12:2- I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago—whether in the body I do not know, or out of the body I do not know, God knows—such a man was caught up to the third heaven.

### <u>18</u>

Rev. 18:23- and the light of a lamp will not shine in you any longer; and the voice of the bridegroom and bride will not be heard in you any longer; for **your merchants were the great** 

men of the earth, because all the nations were deceived by your sorcery.

Job 1:21-He said, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, And naked I shall return there. The LORD gave and the LORD has taken away. Blessed be the name of the LORD."

1 Tim. 6:7-For we have brought nothing into the world, so we cannot take anything out of it either.

Matt. 25:31- But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne.

## <u>20</u>

Eccles. 3:11- He has made everything appropriate in its time. He has also set eternity in their heart, yet so that man will not find out the work which God has done from the beginning even to the end.

2 Thess. 2:9- *that is*, the one whose coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power and signs and false wonders.

Rev. 13:16-18-<sup>16</sup> And he causes all, the small and the great, and the rich and the poor, and the free men and the slaves, to be given a mark on their right hand or on their forehead, <sup>17</sup> and *he provides* that no one will be able to buy or to sell, except the one who has the mark, *either* the name of the beast or the number of his name. <sup>18</sup> Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for the number is that of a man; and his number is six hundred and sixty-six.

Rev. 13:15-15 And it was given to him to give breath to the image of the beast, so that the image of the beast would even speak and cause as many as do not worship the image of the beast to be killed.

Matt. 4:4- But He answered and said, "It is written, 'MAN SHALL NOT LIVE ON BREAD ALONE, BUT ON EVERY WORD THAT PROCEEDS OUT OF THE MOUTH OF GOD.""

Heb. 4:12-For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

2 Thess. 2:8-Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will slay with the breath of His mouth and bring to an end by the appearance of His coming.

Isa. 11:4-But with righteousness He will judge the poor, And decide with fairness for the afflicted of the earth; And He will strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips He will slay the wicked.

Ezek. 39:17-19-<sup>17</sup> "As for you, son of man, thus says the Lord GOD, 'Speak to every kind of bird and to every beast of the field, "Assemble and come, gather from every side to My sacrifice which I am going to sacrifice for you, as a great sacrifice on the mountains of Israel, that you may eat flesh and drink blood. <sup>18</sup> You will eat the flesh of mighty men and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, as *though they were* rams, lambs, goats and bulls, all of them fatlings of Bashan. <sup>19</sup> So you

will eat fat until you are glutted, and drink blood until you are drunk, from My sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.

Matt. 24:27-28-<sup>27</sup> For just as the lightning comes from the east and flashes even to the west, so will the coming of the Son of Man be. <sup>28</sup> Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather.
