"At the very least, it would be confusing to John's first century readers, as well as to later generations, for him to write so much about Babylon when he really meant Rome (Paul was not afraid to speak directly against Rome in his writings, so why should John be?) or 'the false church' (all the apostles', including John, wrote plainly and scathingly about false teachers and false doctrines in the church and would not hide their teachings by symbols). It must be stressed that Revelation means "unveiling," not "veiling," in the absence of any statement in the text to the contrary, therefore, we must assume that the term Babylon applies to the real city of Babylon..."

"How can <u>Gog and Magog</u> refer to a battle in Revelation 19 before the millennium and this battle at the end of the millennium? The most likely explanation is that Antichrist is <u>Gog</u> and will be defeated at the Second Coming. During the millennium his defeat will become a legend among the nations, something like Napoleon's defeat at <u>Waterloo</u>. Then at the end of the millennial kingdom the <u>Gog and Magog</u> 'legend' is applied to a new historical situation (20: 8), with Satan leading the new '<u>Gog and Magog</u>,' Satan will meet his '<u>Waterloo'</u>—his '<u>Gog and Magog</u>,' Satan will meet his '<u>Waterloo'</u>—his '<u>Gog and Magog</u>,'







- Judges 17:6-In those days there was no king in Israel; every man did what was right in his own eyes.
- Judges 18:1-<u>In those days there was no king of Israel</u>; and in those days the tribe of the Danites was seeking an inheritance for themselves to live in, for until that day an inheritance had not been allotted to them as a possession among the tribes of Israel.
- Judges 19:1-Now it came about in those days, when there was no king in Israel, that there was a certain Levite staying in the remote part of the hill country of Ephraim, who took a concubine for himself from Bethlehem in Judah.
- Judges 21:25-In those days there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes.
- Ps. 51:5- Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, And in sin my mother conceived me.
- Jas. 4:1-3-What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage war in your members? ² You lust and do not have; *so* you commit murder. You are envious and cannot obtain; *so* you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask. ³ You ask and do not

receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend *it* on your pleasures.
