"How can **Gog and Magog** refer to a battle in Revelation 19 before the millennium and this battle at the end of the millennium? The most likely explanation is that Antichrist is **Gog** and will be defeated at the Second Coming. During the millennium his defeat will become a legend among the nations, something like Napoleon's defeat at **Waterloo**. Then at the end of the millennial kingdom the **Gog and Magog** 'legend' is applied to a new historical situation (20: 8), with Satan leading the new '**Gog and Magog**.' Satan will meet his '**Waterloo**'—his '**Gog and Magog**.'"

## 2

Rev. 12:9-and the great **dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan**, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

2 Pet. 2:10-11-<sup>10</sup> and especially those who indulge the flesh in *its* corrupt desires and despise authority. Daring, self-willed, they do not tremble when they revile angelic majesties, <sup>11</sup> whereas angels who are greater in might and power do not bring a reviling judgment against them before the Lord.

Jude 9-But Michael the archangel, when he disputed with the devil and argued about the body of Moses, did not dare pronounce against him a railing judgment, but said, “The Lord rebuke you!”

Jas. 4:7-Submit therefore to God. **Resist the devil** and he will flee from you.

1 Pet. 5:8-9-<sup>8</sup> Be of sober *spirit*, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. <sup>9</sup> But **resist him**, firm in *your* faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world.



Eph. 6:13-Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to **resist** in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm.

Matt. 4:3-4-<sup>3</sup> And the tempter came and said to Him, “If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.”<sup>4</sup> But He answered and said, “It is written, ‘MAN SHALL NOT LIVE ON BREAD ALONE, BUT ON EVERY WORD THAT PROCEEDS OUT OF THE MOUTH OF GOD.’”

### **4**

1 Cor. 6:2-3-<sup>2</sup> Or do you not know that the saints will judge the world? If the world is judged by you, are you not competent *to constitute* the smallest law courts?<sup>3</sup> Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more matters of this life?

Dan. 12:1-2-<sup>1</sup>Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands guard over the sons of your people, will arise. And **there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time your people,** everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued.  
<sup>2</sup>Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will

awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace and everlasting contempt.

Rev. 6:9-11-<sup>9</sup> When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God, and because of the testimony which they had maintained; <sup>10</sup> and they cried out with a loud voice, saying, “How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?” <sup>11</sup> And there was given to each of them a white robe; and they were told that they should rest for a little while longer, until *the number* of their fellow servants and their brethren who were to be killed even as they had been, would be completed also.

Rev. 19:13-*He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called **The Word of God**.

John 1:1-In the beginning was **the Word**, and the **Word** was with God, and the **Word** was God.

John 1:14-And the **Word** became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Rev. 13:4-they **worshiped** the dragon because he gave his authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, “Who is like the beast, and who is able to wage war with him?”

Rev. 13:15-And it was given to him to give breath to **the image** of the beast, so that the image of the beast would even speak and

cause as many as do not worship the image of the beast to be killed.

Rev. 13:16-18-<sup>16</sup> And he causes all, the small and the great, and the rich and the poor, and the free men and the slaves, to be given a **mark** on their right hand or on their forehead, <sup>17</sup> and *he provides* that no one will be able to buy or to sell, except the one who has the mark, *either* the name of the beast or the number of his name. <sup>18</sup> Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for the number is that of a man; and his number is six hundred and sixty-six.

1 Cor. 6:2-3-<sup>2</sup> Or do you not know that the saints will judge the world? If the world is judged by you, are you not competent *to constitute* the smallest law courts? <sup>3</sup> Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more matters of this life?

John 15:18-19-<sup>18</sup> “If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before *it hated* you. <sup>19</sup> If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, because of this the world hates you.

2 Tim. 3:12-Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

Dan. 2:40-41-<sup>40</sup> Then there will be a fourth kingdom as strong as iron; inasmuch as iron crushes and shatters all things, so, like iron that breaks in pieces, it will crush and break all these in

pieces. <sup>41</sup> In that you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, it will be a divided kingdom; but it will have in it the toughness of iron, inasmuch as you saw the iron mixed with common clay.

Dan. 7:7-After this I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, a fourth beast, dreadful and terrifying and extremely strong; and it had large iron teeth. It devoured and crushed and trampled down the remainder with its feet; and it was different from all the beasts that were before it, and it had ten horns.

Dan. 9:26-27-<sup>26</sup> Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end *will come* with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined. <sup>27</sup> And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations *will come* one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate.

Dan. 11:35-36-<sup>35</sup> Some of those who have insight will fall, in order to refine, purge and make them pure until the end time; because *it is still to come* at the appointed time. <sup>36</sup> "Then the king will do as he pleases, and he will exalt and magnify himself above every god and will speak monstrous things against the God of gods; and he will prosper until the indignation is finished, for that which is decreed will be done.

Rev. 20:14-Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the **second death**, the lake of fire.

Rev. 2:11-He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes will not be hurt by the **second death**.

## **8**

John 8:44-You are of *your* father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *nature*, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Rev. 12:9-and the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, **who deceives the whole world**; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

Rev. 7:1-After this I saw four angels standing at **the four corners of the earth**, holding back the four winds of the earth, so that no wind would blow on the earth or on the sea or on any tree.

Rev. 12:17-So the dragon was enraged with the woman, and went off to make **war** with the rest of her children, who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus.

Rev. 19:11- And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages **war**.

1 Pet. 3:20-who once were disobedient, when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah, during the construction

of the ark, in which a few, that is, **eight** persons, were brought safely through *the* water.

2 Pet. 2:5-and did not spare the ancient world, but preserved **Noah**, a preacher of righteousness, with **seven others**, when He brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly.

Ephes. 3:10- so that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly *places*.

Judges 17:6-In those days **there was no king in Israel; every man did what was right in his own eyes.**

Judges 18:1-**In those days there was no king of Israel;** and in those days the tribe of the Danites was seeking an inheritance for themselves to live in, for until that day an inheritance had not been allotted to them as a possession among the tribes of Israel.

Judges 19:1-Now it came about in those days, **when there was no king in Israel,** that there was a certain Levite staying in the remote part of the hill country of Ephraim, who took a concubine for himself from Bethlehem in Judah.

Judges 21:25-In those days there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes.

Ps. 51:5- Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, And in sin my mother conceived me.

Jas. 4:1-3-What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage war in your members? <sup>2</sup> You lust and do not have; *so* you commit murder. You are envious and cannot obtain; *so* you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask. <sup>3</sup> You ask and do not

receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend *it* on your pleasures.

John 3:3-5-<sup>3</sup> Jesus answered and said to him, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God.”<sup>4</sup> Nicodemus \*said to Him, “How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother’s womb and be born, can he?”<sup>5</sup> Jesus answered, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

2 Pet. 1:4- For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become **partakers of the divine nature**, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.

Ps. 78:68- But chose the tribe of Judah, **Mount Zion which He loved**.

Ps. 87:2- The LORD **loves the gates of Zion** More than all the *other* dwelling places of Jacob.

Gen. 19:24-Then the LORD rained on Sodom and Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven.

Eccles. 3:11-He has made everything appropriate in its time. He has also **set eternity in their heart**, yet so that man will not find
