What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate."
- Gen. 2:24- For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother, and be joined to his wife; and they shall become one flesh.
- Gen. 4:23- Lamech said to his <u>wives</u>, "Adah and Zillah, Listen to my voice, You wives of Lamech, Give heed to my speech, For I have killed a man for wounding me; And a boy for striking me.
- Heb. 13:4-Marriage *is to be held* in honor among all, and the *marriage* bed *is to be* undefiled; for fornicators and adulterers God will judge.

Matt. 5:33-37-³³ "Again, you have heard that the ancients were told, 'YOU SHALL NOT MAKE FALSE VOWS, BUT SHALL FULFILL YOUR VOWS TO THE LORD.' ³⁴ But I say to you, make no oath at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of God, ³⁵ or by the earth, for it is the footstool of His feet, or by Jerusalem, for it is THE CITY OF THE GREAT KING. ³⁶ Nor shall you make an oath by your head, for you cannot make one hair white or black. ³⁷ But let your statement be, 'Yes, yes' *or* 'No, no'; anything beyond these is of evil.

Rev. 2:11- He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes will not be hurt by the **second death**.

Rev. 20:6-Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the **second death** has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.

Rev. 20:14-Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the **second death**, the lake of fire.

John 3:3-5-3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." ⁴ Nicodemus *said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?" ⁵ Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

John 3:7- "Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye <u>must</u> be born anew."
