# **Cross References**

John 1:5-The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

John 3:2-this man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You have come from God *as* a teacher; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him.

John 3:19-This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil.

Mark 6:48-Seeing them straining at the oars, for the wind was against them, at about the fourth watch of the night He came to them, walking on the sea; and He intended to pass by them.

James 1:2-4-Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, <sup>3</sup> knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. <sup>4</sup> And let endurance have *its* perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Matt 14:24-But the boat was already a long distance from the land, battered by the waves; for the wind was contrary

Mark 6:47-When it was evening, the boat was in the middle of the sea, and He was alone on the land.

Mark 6:49-But when they saw Him walking on the sea, they supposed that it was a ghost, and cried out

John 8:58-59-Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am." <sup>59</sup> Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple

Exod 3:14-God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you." 1 John 4:18-There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love

Heb 2:15-and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives

Philip 4:6-7-Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Josh 1:6-7-Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. <sup>7</sup> Only be strong and very courageous; be careful to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may have success wherever you go.

2 Tim 1:7-For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline

Rev 1:17-When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. And He placed His right hand on me, saying, "Do not be afraid; I am the first and the last

Rev 2:10-Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, so that you will be tested, and you will have tribulation for ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life

Rev 21:8-But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part *will be* in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

Matt 23:37- Jerusalem, Jerusalem, who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, the way a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you were unwilling.

Psalm 23:1-2- The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not want. <sup>2</sup> He makes me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters.

John 6:10- Jesus said, "Have the people sit down." Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

Psalm 34:7- The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, And rescues them.

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, <sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen
