Gen 12:3-And I will bless those who bless you, And the one who ^[a]curses you I will ^[b]curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed

Isa 42:6-I am the LORD, I have called You in righteousness, I will also hold You by the hand and watch over You, And I will appoint You as a covenant to the people, As a light to the nations.

Isa 49:6-He says, "It is too ^[a]small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob and to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also make You a light ^[b]of the nations So that My salvation may ^[c]reach to the end of the earth.

Ruth 1:16-But Ruth said, "Do not urge me to leave you *or* turn back from following you; for where you go, I will go, and where you lodge, I will lodge. Your people *shall be* my people, and your God, my God.

Acts 10:1-2-Now *there was* a man at Caesarea named Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian ^[a]cohort, ² a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, and gave many ^[b]alms to the *Jewish* people and prayed to God continually.

John 3:16-For God so loved the world, that He gave His [a] only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life

- Acts 10:14-But Peter said, "By no means, Lord, for I have never eaten anything [a]unholy and unclean.
- John 17:5-Now, Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.
- John 2:4-And Jesus *said to her, "Woman, [a] what does that have to do with us? My hour has not yet come."
- John 4:21-Jesus *said to her, "Woman, believe Me, an hour is coming when neither in this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father.
- John 4:23-But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers.
- John 7:30-So they were seeking to seize Him; and no man laid his hand on Him, because His hour had not yet come.
- John 8:20-These words He spoke in the treasury, as He taught in the temple; and no one seized Him, because His hour had not yet come.
- John 12:27-Now My soul has become troubled; and what shall I say, 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour
- John 13:1-Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He would depart out of this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them ^[a] to the end.
- John 17:1-Jesus spoke these things; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, that the Son may glorify You

Dan 7:13-14-I kept looking in the night visions, And behold, with the clouds of heaven One like a Son of Man was coming, And He came up to the Ancient of Days And was presented before Him. ¹⁴ "And to Him was given dominion, Glory and ^[a]a kingdom, That all the peoples, nations and *men of every* ^[b]language Might serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion Which will not pass away; And His kingdom is one Which will not be destroyed.

Mark 15:61-64-But He kept silent and did not answer. Again the high priest was questioning Him, and ^[a] saying to Him, "Are You ^[b] the Christ, the Son of the Blessed *One*?" ⁶² And Jesus said, "I am; and you shall see THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, and COMING WITH THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN." ⁶³ Tearing his clothes, the high priest *said, "What further need do we have of witnesses? ⁶⁴ You have heard the blasphemy; how does it seem to you?" And they all condemned Him to be deserving of death.

John 3:5-Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God

Rev 22:17-The Spirit and the bride say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who wishes take the water of life without cost.

John 3:16-For God so loved the world, that He gave His ^[a] only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life

John 5:24- Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.

John 6:40- For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day

John 6:47- Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life.

- Gal 3:3-Are you so foolish? Having begun ^[a] by the Spirit, are you now ^[b] being perfected by the flesh?
- Gal 5:16-But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.
- 2 Tim 2:11-13- It is a trustworthy statement: For if we died with Him, we will also live with Him; ¹² If we endure, we will also reign with Him; If we ^[a]deny Him, He also will deny us; ¹³ If we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself.
- Luke 14:26- If anyone comes to Me, and does not ^[a]hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be My disciple
- Rom 9:13-Just as it is written, "JACOB I LOVED, BUT ESAU I HATED."
- John 10:10- The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and [a] have *it* abundantly
- Gal 6:8- For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life
- Gen 3:5-For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.
- Isa 14:14- I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High
- Matt 10:32-33- Therefore everyone who ^[a]confesses Me before men, I will also confess ^[b]him before My Father who is in heaven. ³³ But whoever ^[c]denies Me before men, I will also deny him before My Father who is in heaven.
- Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep [a]through the blood of the eternal covenant,

even Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
