John 1:15-John testified about Him and cried out, saying, “This was He of whom I said, ‘He who comes after me has a higher rank than I, for He existed before me.’”

John 7:28-Then Jesus cried out in the temple, teaching and saying, “You both know Me and know where I am from; and I have not come of Myself, but He who sent Me is true, whom you do not know.

John 7:37-Now on the last day, the great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “<sup>1</sup>If anyone is thirsty, <sup>1</sup>let him come to Me and drink.

John 10:30-I and the Father are one.

John 14:9-Jesus said to him, “Have I been so long with you, and *yet* you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how *can* you say, ‘Show us the Father’?

Exod 33:20-But He said, “You cannot see My face, for no man can see Me and live!”

John 1:18-No one has seen God at any time; the only begotten God who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained *Him*.

Col 1:15-He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.

Heb 1:3-And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high

John 1:4-8-In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. <sup>5</sup> The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not <sup>[a]</sup>comprehend it. <sup>6</sup> There <sup>[b]</sup>came a man sent from God, whose name was John. <sup>7</sup> <sup>[c]</sup>He

came <sup>[d]</sup>as a witness, to testify about the Light, so that all might believe through him. <sup>8</sup> <sup>[e]</sup>He was not the Light, but *he came* to testify about the Light.

John 3:19-21-This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil. <sup>20</sup> For everyone who does evil hates the Light, and does not come to the Light for fear that his deeds will be exposed. <sup>21</sup> But he who practices the truth comes to the Light, so that his deeds may be manifested as having been wrought in God.

John 3:3-Jesus answered and said to him, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born <sup>[a]</sup>again he cannot see the kingdom of God.

1 Cor 2:14-But <sup>[a]</sup>a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually <sup>[b]</sup>appraised.

Acts 26:17-18-rescuing you from the *Jewish* people and from the Gentiles, to whom I am sending you, <sup>18</sup> to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.

Col 1:12-13-giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us <sup>[a]</sup>to share in the inheritance of the <sup>[b]</sup>saints in Light. <sup>13</sup> <sup>[c]</sup>For He rescued us from the <sup>[d]</sup>domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of <sup>[e]</sup>His beloved Son.

Eph 2:1-And you <sup>[a]</sup>were dead <sup>[b]</sup>in your trespasses and sins

Gen 2:16-17-The LORD God commanded the man, saying, “From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; <sup>17</sup> but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not <sup>[a]</sup>eat, for in the day that you eat from it you will surely die.

2 Cor 4:4-in whose case the god of this <sup>[a]</sup>world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving <sup>[b]</sup>so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

John 12:31-Now judgment is upon this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out.

1 John 5:19-We know that we are of God, and that the whole world lies in *the power of* the evil one.

John 3:17-For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

2 Thess 1:8-dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus

Rev 19:11-21-And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war. <sup>12</sup> His eyes *are* a flame of fire, and on His head *are* many diadems; and He has a name written *on Him* which no one knows except Himself. <sup>13</sup> *He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. <sup>14</sup> And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses. <sup>15</sup> From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will <sup>[a]</sup>rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the <sup>[b]</sup>wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty. <sup>16</sup> And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS."<sup>17</sup> Then I saw <sup>[c]</sup>an angel standing in the sun, and he cried out with a loud voice, saying to all the birds which fly in midheaven, "Come, assemble for the great supper of God, <sup>18</sup> so that you may eat the flesh of kings and the flesh of <sup>[d]</sup>commanders and the flesh of mighty men and the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them and the flesh of all men, both free men and slaves, and small and great."<sup>19</sup> And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies assembled to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.<sup>20</sup> And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet

who performed the signs <sup>[e]</sup>in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with <sup>[f]</sup>brimstone. <sup>21</sup> And the rest were killed with the sword which came from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse, and all the birds were filled with their flesh.

John 1:12-But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, *even* to those who believe in His name.

John 11:23-Jesus \*said to her, “Your brother will rise again.”

Dan 12:2-Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace *and* everlasting <sup>[a]</sup>contempt.

John 5:28-29-Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice, <sup>29</sup> and will come forth; those who did the good *deeds* to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil *deeds* to a resurrection of judgment.

John 3:16-For God so loved the world, that He gave His <sup>[a]</sup>only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

John 5:24-Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.

John 6:47-Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life.

Rev 3:5-He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.

Rev 20:12-13, 15- And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and <sup>[a]</sup>books were opened; and another <sup>[b]</sup>book was opened, which is *the book* of life; and the dead were judged from the

things which were written in the <sup>[c]</sup>books, according to their deeds.

<sup>13</sup> And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one *of them* according to their deeds...And if <sup>[a]</sup>anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Rom 5:9-Much more then, having now been justified <sup>[e]</sup>by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath *of God* through Him.

Rom 8:1-Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

1 Thess 1:10-and to wait for His Son from <sup>[a]</sup>heaven, whom He raised from the dead, *that is* Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath to come..

1 Thess 5:9-For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Rev 3:10-Because you have kept the word of My <sup>[a]</sup>perseverance, I also will keep you from the hour of <sup>[b]</sup>testing, that *hour* which is about to come upon the whole <sup>[c]</sup>world, to <sup>[d]</sup>test those who dwell on the earth.

Gen 2:16-17-The LORD God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; <sup>17</sup> but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not <sup>[a]</sup>eat, for in the day that you eat from it you will surely die.

Rom 6:23- or the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Eph 2:1-And you <sup>[a]</sup>were dead <sup>[b]</sup>in your trespasses and sins

Rom 8:9- However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.

1 Cor 6:19- Or do you not know that your body is a <sup>[a]</sup>temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from <sup>[b]</sup>God, and that you are not your own?

Titus 3:5- He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit.

Rom 16:26- but now is manifested, and by the Scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the eternal God, has been made known to all the nations, *leading* to obedience of faith

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep <sup>[a]</sup>through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, <sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
