



1. The believers' union with Christ
2. Restoration of broken fellowship with God
3. Abiding in Christ as a prerequisite for fruit bearing
4. A new relationship to the Holy Spirit 
5. A new relationship between believers
6. A new ground for prayer 
7. A new hope


I am the Bread of Life	6:35

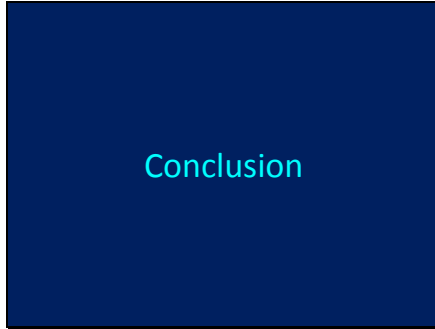

John 12:37- But though He had performed so many signs before them, *yet* they were not believing in Him.

Matt. 16:18- I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.

Eph 2:20-having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner *stone*,

Ephesians 4:32-Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

Matt 18:34-And his lord, moved with anger, handed him over to the torturers until he should repay all that was owed him.

Luke 23:34-But Jesus was saying, “Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.” And they cast lots, dividing up His garments among themselves.

John 2:11-This beginning of *His* signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him.

John 15:16-You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you.

Exodus 3:14-God said to Moses, “[a]I AM WHO [b]I AM”; and He said, “Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, ‘[c]I AM has sent me to you.’”

John 8:58-59-Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham [a]was born, I am.”⁵⁹ Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus [b]hid Himself and went out of the temple.

Matt 24:1-2-Jesus came out from the temple and was going away [a]when His disciples came up to point out the temple buildings to Him.² And He said to them, “Do you not see all these things? Truly I say to you, not one stone here will be left upon another, which will not be torn down.”

Matt 24:15-Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand).

Isaiah 48:3, 5-I declared the former things long ago And they went forth from My mouth, and I proclaimed them. Suddenly I acted, and they came to pass...⁵Therefore I declared *them* to you long ago, Before they took place I proclaimed *them* to you, So that you would not say, ‘My

idol has done them, And my graven image and my molten image have commanded them.’

John 12:44-And Jesus cried out and said, “He who believes in Me, does not believe in Me but in Him who sent Me.

John 20:21-So Jesus said to them again, “Peace *be* with you; as the Father has sent Me, I also send you.”

1 Sam 8:6-7-But the thing was ^[a]displeasing in the sight of Samuel when they said, “Give us a king to judge us.” And Samuel prayed to the LORD. The LORD said to Samuel, “Listen to the voice of the people in regard to all that they say to you, for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected Me from being king over them.

John 11:33- When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews who came with her *also* weeping, He was deeply moved in spirit and ^[a]was troubled

John 15:14-15-You are My friends if you do what I command you. ¹⁵ No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
