Isa 9:6-7- For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will ^[a]rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. ⁷ There will be no end to the increase of *His* government or of peace, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will accomplish this.

Rom 5:1- Therefore, having been justified by faith, ^[a]we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Matt 8:24- And behold, there arose [a] a great storm on the sea, so that the boat was being covered with the waves; but Jesus Himself was asleep.

Gal 2:20-I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and ^[a]the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Rom 5:10- For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

Philip 4:7- And the peace of God, which surpasses all ^[d]comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Philip 4:6- Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

- Heb 11:6-And without faith it is impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and *that* He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.
- Rev 21:8-But for the cowardly and ^[a]unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part *will be* in the lake that burns with fire and ^[b]brimstone, which is the second death.
- John 14:18- I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.
- John 14:17-18- *that is* the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, *but* you know Him because He abides with you and will be in you. ¹⁸ "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.
- John 17:5- Now, Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.
- John 10:30-I and the Father are [a] one.
- John 13:19- From now on I am telling you before *it* comes to pass, so that when it does occur, you may believe that I am *He*.
- John 6:70- Jesus answered them, "Did I Myself not choose you, the twelve, and *yet* one of you is a devil?"
- John 13:27- After the morsel, Satan then entered into him. Therefore Jesus *said to him, "What you do, do quickly."
- 2 Cor 12:7- Because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, for this reason, to keep me from exalting myself, there was given me a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to [a] torment me—to keep me from exalting myself!

Ezek 28;13, 15-You were in Eden, the garden of God; Every precious stone was your covering: The ruby, the topaz and the diamond; The beryl, the onyx and the jasper; The lapis lazuli, the turquoise and the emerald; And the gold, the workmanship of your ^[e]settings and ^[f]sockets, Was in you. On the day that you were created They were prepared.... ¹⁵ "You were blameless in your ways From the day you were created Until unrighteousness was found in you.

John 14:15- If you love Me, you will keep My commandments

John 14:21- He who has My commandments and keeps them is the one who loves Me; and he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and will disclose Myself to him."

John 14:24- He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine, but the Father's who sent Me.

Constable- Many commentators interpreted the final sentence in this verse as an indication that Jesus ended His discourse here, and that He and the Eleven left the upper room immediately. They viewed the teaching and praying, that we find in chapters 15—17, as happening somewhere in Jerusalem near the Kidron Valley—before Jesus' arrest (cf. 18:1). However, it seems more probable to many interpreters, including myself, that this sentence did not signal a real change of location—but only an anticipated change, in view of 18:1.

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep [a]through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every

good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
