John 1:4-5-In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men.
⁵ The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not
 [a] comprehend it.

John 8:12- Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, “I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life.”

John 7:7- The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it, that its deeds are evil.

John 3:19-20- This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil. ²⁰ For everyone who does evil hates the Light, and does not come to the Light for fear that his deeds will be exposed.

Matt 23:34-Therefore, behold, I am sending you prophets and wise men and scribes; some of them you will kill and crucify, and some of them you will scourge in your synagogues, and persecute from city to city.

Rev. 11:3, 7-10-And I will grant *authority* to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for twelve hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth... When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them and kill them. ⁸ And their dead bodies *will lie* in the street of the great city which ^[f]mystically is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was crucified. ⁹ Those from the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations *will* look at their dead ^[g]bodies for three and a half days, and ^[h]will not permit their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb. ¹⁰ And those who dwell on the earth *will* rejoice over them and celebrate; and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.

1 Thess 5:5-for you are all sons of light and sons of day. We are not of night nor of darkness.

Matt. 5:14-16-You are the light of the world. A city set on a ^[a]hill cannot be hidden; ¹⁵ nor does *anyone* light a lamp and put it under a ^[b]basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all

who are in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

Eph. 5:11-Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even ^[a]expose them.

John 3:16- For God so loved the world, that He gave His ^[a]only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Ps 35:19- Do not let those who are wrongfully my enemies rejoice over me; Nor let those who hate me without cause ^[a]wink maliciously.

Ps 69:4- Those who hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of my head; Those who would ^[a]destroy me are powerful, being wrongfully my enemies; What I did not steal, I then have to restore.

1 Sam. 16:13-14- Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon David from that day forward. And Samuel arose and went to Ramah. ¹⁴ Now the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD terrorized him.

2 Sam. 7:12-16- When your days are complete and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your ^[c]descendant after you, who will come forth from ^[d]you, and I will establish his kingdom. ¹³ He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. ¹⁴ I will be a father

to him and he will be a son to Me; when he commits iniquity, I will correct him with the rod of men and the strokes of the sons of men, ¹⁵ but My lovingkindness shall not depart from him, as I took *it* away from Saul, whom I removed from before you. ¹⁶ Your house and your kingdom shall endure before ^[e]Me forever; your throne shall be established forever.”””

John 7:39- But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

John 16:7- But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the ^[a]Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.

Acts 1:5- for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized ^[a]with the Holy Spirit ^[b]not many days from now.

RSB pg. 1326-"In the root of this word are the ideas of advising, exhorting, comforting, strengthening, interceding, and encouraging."

Gen 2:18- Then the LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper ^[a]suitable for him."

Ps 54:4- Behold, God is my helper; The Lord is the sustainer of my soul.

John 7:39- But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

John 16:7- But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the ^[a]Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.

John 14:16- I will ask the Father, and He will give you another ^[a]Helper, that He may be with you forever.

1 John 2:27- As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, ^[i]you abide in Him.

Eph 4:25- Therefore, laying aside falsehood, SPEAK TRUTH EACH ONE *of you* WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, for we are members of one another.

Constable p. 258-The basis of their testimony would be their long association with, and intimate knowledge of, Jesus (cf. Acts 1:21-22).

Acts 1:21-22- Therefore it is necessary that of the men who have accompanied us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out ^[a]among us—²² beginning ^[b]with the baptism of John until the day that He was taken up from us—one of these *must* become a witness with us of His resurrection.

Heb. 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep ^[a]through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
