

Constable-"Jesus' method of teaching in the Upper Room Discourse was not to give a thorough explanation of one subject, then a thorough explanation of another subject, and so on. It was rather to introduce several subjects initially, then return to them and give a little more information, then return again and give even more information. This is, of course, excellent teaching methodology. This is also the method that John employed in writing his first epistle."

John 9:22-His parents said this because they were afraid of the Jews; for the Jews had already agreed that if anyone confessed Him to be Christ, he was to be put out of the synagogue.

John 9:34-They answered him, "You were born entirely in sins, and are you teaching us?" So they put him out.

Mark 7:13- *thus* invalidating the word of God by your tradition which you have handed down; and you do many things such as that.

Philip 3:6-as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to the righteousness which is in the Law, found blameless.

Heb 9:27-And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this *comes* judgment.

Gen. 4:1-Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, and said, "I have acquired a man from the LORD." (NKJV)

John 14:6-Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

John 10:30-I and My Father are one.

John 17:5-And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

John 13:36-Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, where are You going?" Jesus answered him, "Where I am going you cannot follow Me now, but you shall follow Me afterward."

John 14:5-Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?"

Prov 4:23-Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it *spring* the issues of life (NKJV).
