2 Tim 3:17-so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

2 Peter 1:3-4-seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence. ⁴ For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of *the* divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.

Constable-Jesus never acted on His "own initiative," but only in obedience to the Father. "The Spirit," who would reveal "the truth," would do the same.

John 5:19-Therefore Jesus answered and was saying to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, unless *it is* something He sees the Father doing; for whatever ^[a]the Father does, these things the Son also does in like manner.

Matt 24:36- But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone.

1 John 4:1-Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

Rev 2:2-'I know your deeds and your toil and ^[a]perseverance, and that you cannot tolerate evil men, and you put to the test

those who call themselves apostles, and they are not, and you found them *to be* false

Acts 17:11- Now these were more noble-minded than those in Thessalonica, ^[a]for they received the word with ^[b]great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily *to see* whether these things were so.

1 Thess 5:21-But examine everything *carefully*; hold fast to that which is good; ²² abstain from every ^[m]form of evil.

Gal 1:6-9-I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you ^[a]by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel; ⁷ which is *really* not another; only there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the gospel of Christ. ⁸ But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel ^[b]contrary to what we have preached to you, he is to be ^[c]accursed! ⁹ As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is preaching to you a gospel ^[d]contrary to what you received, he is to be ^[e]accursed!

Dt. 13:1-5-f a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder, ² and the sign or the wonder comes true, concerning which he spoke to you, saying, ‘Let us go after other gods (whom you have not known) and let us serve them,’ ³ you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams; for the LORD your God is testing you to find out if you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. ⁴ You shall follow the LORD your God and fear

Him; and you shall keep His commandments, listen to His voice, serve Him, and cling to Him. ⁵ But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams shall be put to death, because he has ^[b]counseled ^[c]rebellion against the LORD your God who brought you from the land of Egypt and redeemed you from the house of ^[d]slavery, to seduce you from the way in which the LORD your God commanded you to walk. So you shall purge the evil from among you.

1 Cor 14:29-Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others pass judgment.

John 16:2-They will make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering service to God.

John 14:26- But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

John 16:13-But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

Gen 18:17-The LORD said, "Shall I hide from Abraham what I am about to do."

Amos 3:7-Surely the Lord GOD does nothing Unless He reveals His secret counsel To His servants the prophets.

Dan. 12:10-Many will be purged, purified and refined, but the wicked will act wickedly; and none of the wicked will understand, but those who have insight will understand.

Rev. 1:3-Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and heed the things which are written in it; for the time is near.

Titus 2:13- looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus.

Rev. 21:4-and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be *any* death; there will no longer be *any* mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away

2 Pet 3:10-11-But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and ^[a]its works will be ^[b]burned up.¹¹ Since all these things are to be destroyed in this way, what sort of people ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness

1 John 3:2-3-Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is.³ And everyone who has this hope *fixed* on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

Ryrie-"Eschatology seems to suffer at the hands of both its friends and foes. Those who play it down usually avoid assigning specific meaning to the prophetic texts. Those who

plat it up often assign too much. But the prophetic portions of the Bible won't go away. The biblical interpreter must interact with them and in the detail and specificity in which they were written."

Amsbaugh "Is Prophecy Just for Kooks"- "Part of this animate repudiation of prophecy stems from some of the "poster children" who support it. We often think of the prophecy student as one who owns a fallout shelter in his backyard, brings his own distilled water to church in a half-gallon jug, and has a yellow glow from the overabundance of carrots that he has juiced for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. In short, we think that prophecy students are kooks. They constantly monitor the buzzard population in the Holy Land to see if Armageddon is near, look for 666 on Jerusalem license plates to see if anti-Christ is on the horizon, and track the births of red heifers to see how close we are to a rebuilt temple. I suspect that we shy away from prophecy, in part, because we do not want to be branded with the group that is "into it.""

Warren- "When the disciples wanted to talk about prophecy, Jesus quickly switched the conversation to evangelism. He wanted them to concentrate on their mission in the world. He said in essence, "The details of my return are none of your business. What is your business is the mission I have given you. Focus on that!" (*PDL*, p. 285)."

Rev. 22:16-I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things ^[a]for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star.

2 Tim. 3:16-All Scripture is ^[a]inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for ^[b]training in righteousness.

Matt. 23:35-so that upon you may fall *the guilt of* all the righteous blood shed on earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, whom you murdered between the ^[a]temple and the altar

Matt. 24:35-Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away

Matt. 5:17-18- “Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but to fulfill. ¹⁸ For truly I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not the smallest letter or stroke shall pass from the Law until all is accomplished.

1 Cor. 7:10- But to the married I give instructions, not I, but the Lord, that the wife should not leave her husband.

1 Cor. 7:12-But to the rest I say, not the Lord, that if any brother has a wife who is an unbeliever, and she consents to live with him, he must not ^[f]divorce her.

1 Thess. 2:13-For this reason we also constantly thank God that when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you accepted *it not as* the word of men, but *for* what it really is,

the word of God, which also performs its work in you who believe.

2 Thess. 3:14-If anyone does not obey our ^[a]instruction ^[b]in this letter, take special note of that person ^[c]and do not associate with him, so that he will be put to shame.

Eph. 3:5-which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets ^[a]in the Spirit.

Luke 24:27-Then beginning ^[g]with Moses and ^[h]with all the prophets, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.

Luke 24:44- Now He said to them, “These are My words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things which are written about Me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled.”

Rev. 19:10- Then I fell at his feet to worship him. But he *said to me, “Do not do that; I am a fellow servant of yours and your brethren who hold the testimony of Jesus; worship God. For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.”

1 Pet. 1:10-11- As to this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the grace that *would come* to you made careful searches and inquiries, ¹¹ ^[a]seeking to know what person or time the Spirit of Christ within them was indicating as He predicted the sufferings of Christ and the glories ^[b]to follow.

2 Tim 3:17-so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.
