

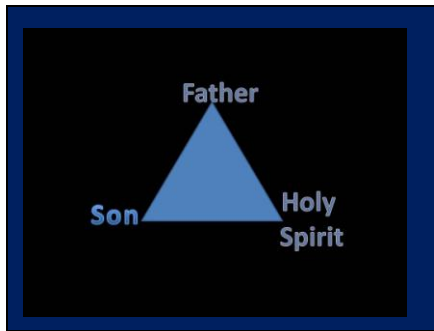

John 3:16-For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

John 2:11-This beginning of His ^[a]signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him.

John 20:30-31-Therefore many other ^[a]signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; ³¹ but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is ^[b]the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name.

John 15:3-You are already ^[a]clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

John 13:30-So after receiving the morsel he went out immediately; and it was night.

John 13:19-From now on I am telling you before *it* comes to pass, so that when it does occur, you may believe that I am *He*.

Matt 26:75-And Peter remembered the word which Jesus had said, “Before a rooster crows, you will deny Me three times.” And he went out and wept bitterly.

1 Peter 1:6-7- In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various [a]trials, ⁷ so that the [b]proof of your faith, *being* more precious than gold which [c]is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ

Matt 27:46-About the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “ELI, ELI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?” that is, “MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?”

2 Cor. 5:21-He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Prov. 18:24-A man of *too many* friends *comes to* [m]ruin, But there is a [n]friend who sticks closer than a brother.

Isa 43:2-When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they will not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be scorched, Nor will the flame burn you.

Dan. 3:24-25-Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astounded and stood up in haste; he said to his high officials, “Was it not three men we cast bound into the midst of the fire?” They replied to the king, “Certainly, O king.”²⁵ He said, “Look! I see four men loosed *and* walking *about* in the midst of the fire ^[a]without harm, and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of *the* gods!”

Matt 28:20- teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you ^[a]always, even to the end of the age.

Heb. 13:5- *Make sure that* your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, “I WILL NEVER DESERT YOU, NOR WILL I EVER FORSAKE YOU,”

Ps 27:10-For my father and my mother have forsaken me, But the LORD will take me up.

John 14:27-Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

Rom. 5:1-Therefore, having been justified by faith, ^[a]we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Philip. 4:6-7, 19-Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.⁷ And the peace of God, which surpasses all ^[d]comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in

Christ Jesus...And my God will supply ^[o]all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

John 15:2-Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away; and every *branch* that bears fruit, He ^[a]prunes it so that it may bear more fruit.

John 12:31-Now judgment is upon this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out.

1 John 2:15-17- Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. ¹⁷ The world is passing away, and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

John 15:18-19-If the world hates you, ^[a]you know that it has hated Me before *it hated* you. ¹⁹ If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, because of this the world hates you.

Acts 14:22-strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith, and *saying*, “Through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God.

Jas 1:2-4-Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various ^[a]trials, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces

[b]endurance. ⁴ And let [c]endurance have *its* perfect [d]result, so that you may be [e]perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Rev. 3:10-Because you have kept the word of My [a]perseverance, I also will keep you from the hour of [b]testing, that *hour* which is about to come upon the whole [c]world, to [d]test those who dwell on the earth.

Rev. 3:13-He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Matt. 9:2-And they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralytic, “Take courage, [a]son; your sins are forgiven.”

Matt. 9:22-But Jesus turning and seeing her said, “Daughter, take courage; your faith has [a]made you well.” [b]At once the woman was [c]made well.

Matt. 14:27- But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, “Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid.”

Mark 6:50-for they all saw Him and were [a]terrified. But immediately He spoke with them and *said to them, “Take courage; it is I, do not be afraid.

Mark 10:49-And Jesus stopped and said, “Call him *here*.” So they *called the blind man, saying to him, “Take courage, stand up! He is calling for you.”

Acts 23:11-But on the night *immediately* following, the Lord stood at his side and said, “Take courage; for as you have solemnly witnessed to My cause at Jerusalem, so you must witness at Rome also.”

John 14:18-I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

1 John 5:4-5-For whatever is ^[f]born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith.⁵ Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

1 John 2:17-The world is passing away, and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

1 John 4:4-You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.

Rom. 8:35-39- Who will separate us from the love of ^[a]Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? ³⁶ Just as it is written, “FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO DEATH ALL DAY LONG; WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED.”³⁷ But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Rev. 2:8, 10, 8-And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write: The first and the last, who ^[a]was dead, and has come to life, says this...¹⁰ Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, so that you will be tested, and you will have tribulation for ten days. ^[b]Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

Matt. 10:27-30-What I tell you in the darkness, speak in the light; and what you hear *whispered* in *your* ear, proclaim upon the housetops. ²⁸ Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in ^[x]hell. ²⁹ Are not two sparrows sold for a ^[y]cent? And *yet* not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. ³⁰ But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

Heb. 13:20-21-Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep ^[g]through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
