



Pretribulationism is not Escapism

Promised Exemption from Divine Wrath

- The promise (1 Thess 1:10; 5:9; Rom 5:9; Rev 3:10)
- Tribulation = divine wrath (Rev 6:16-17; 11:18; 15:1, 7; 16:19)



Rev. 6:16-17

■ "The verb ēlethen ("has come") is aorist indicative, referring to a previous arrival of wrath, not something that is about to take place. Men see the arrival of this day at least as early as the cosmic upheavals that characterize the sixth seal (6:12-14), but upon reflection they probably recognize that it was already in effect with the death of one-fourth of the population (6:7-8), the worldwide famine (6:5-6), and the global warfare (6:3-4). The rapid sequence of all of these events could not escape notice, but the light of their true explanation does not dawn upon human consciousness until the severe phenomena of the sixth seal arrive."

John 12:31-Now judgment is upon this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out.

1 John 2:15-17- Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. ¹⁷ The world is passing away, and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

2 Cor. 5:20-Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

Matt. 13:38-and the field is the world; and *as for* the good seed, these are the sons of the kingdom; and the tares are the sons of the evil *one*

Gal. 4:7-Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir [a]through God.

John 15:18-19-If the world hates you, ^[a]you know that it has hated Me before *it hated* you. ¹⁹ If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, because of this the world hates you.

Jas. 4:4-You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

Acts 14:22-strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith, and *saying*, "Through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God.

Jas 1:2-4-Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various ^[a]trials, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces ^[b]endurance. ⁴ And let ^[c]endurance have *its* perfect ^[d]result, so that you may be ^[e]perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Rev. 3:10-Because you have kept the word of My ^[a]perseverance, I also will keep you from the hour of ^[b]testing, that *hour* which is about to come upon the whole ^[c]world, to ^[d]test those who dwell on the earth.

Joel 2:2-A day of darkness and gloom, A day of clouds and thick darkness. As the dawn is spread over the mountains, *So* there is a great and mighty people; There has never been *anything* like it, Nor will there be again after it To the years of many generations.

Jer. 30:7-'Alas! for that day is great, There is none like it; And it is the time of Jacob's distress, But he will be saved from it.

Dan 12:1-Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands *guard* over the sons of your people, will arise. And there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time your people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued.

Matt 24:21-For then there will be a great tribulation, such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever will.

Rev. 3:13-He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

Rev. 1:19- Therefore write the things which you have seen, and the things which are, and the things which will take place after these things.

- Rev. 22:16- "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things [a] for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star."
- Rev. 13:9-If anyone has an ear, let him hear.
- Gal 3:28- There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is ^[a]neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Eph. 2:14- For He Himself is our peace, who made both *groups* into one and broke down the [a] barrier of the dividing wall.
- Rev. 1:20- As for the mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.
- Rev. 4:5- Out from the throne come flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder. And *there were* seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.
- Matt. 9:2-And they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralytic, "Take courage, ^[a]son; your sins are forgiven."
- Matt. 9:22-But Jesus turning and seeing her said, "Daughter, take courage; your faith has ^[a]made you well." ^[b]At once the woman was ^[c]made well.
- Matt. 14:27- But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid."

Mark 6:50-for they all saw Him and were ^[a]terrified. But immediately He spoke with them and *said to them, "Take courage; it is I, do not be afraid.

Mark 10:49-And Jesus stopped and said, "Call him *here*." So they *called the blind man, saying to him, "Take courage, stand up! He is calling for you."

Acts 23:11-But on the night *immediately* following, the Lord stood at his side and said, "Take courage; for as you have solemnly witnessed to My cause at Jerusalem, so you must witness at Rome also."

John 14:18-I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

Josh 1:6-7- Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. ⁷ Only be strong and very courageous; ^[b] be careful to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may ^[c] have success wherever you go.

Philip 4:6-7- Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which surpasses all ^d comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

2 Tim. 1:7- For God has not given us a spirit of ^[a]timidity, but of power and love and ^[b]discipline.

- Prov. 28:1- The wicked flee when no one is pursuing, But the righteous are ^[a]bold as a lion.
- Rev. 21:8- But for the cowardly and ^[d]unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part *will be* in the lake that burns with fire and ^[e]brimstone, which is the second death."

Luke 4:5-8- And he led Him up and showed Him all the kingdoms of ^[a]the world in a moment of time. ⁶ And the devil said to Him, "I will give You all this domain and ^[b]its glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. ⁷ Therefore if You ^[c]worship before me, it shall all be Yours." ⁸ Jesus answered him, "It is written, 'YOU SHALL WORSHIP THE LORD YOUR GOD AND SERVE HIM ONLY."

- Heb. 4:15- For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as *we are*, *yet* without sin.
- 1 John 5:4-5-For whatever is ^[f]born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. ⁵ Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?
- 1 John 4:4-You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.
- John 14:18-I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

1 John 2:17-The world is passing away, and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

Revelation 18:10-standing at a distance because of the fear of her torment, saying, 'Woe, woe, the great city, Babylon, the strong city! For in one hour your judgment has come.'

2 Cor. 4:18-while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Rom. 8:35-39- Who will separate us from the love of ^[a]Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? ³⁶ Just as it is written, "FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO DEATH ALL DAY LONG; WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED." ³⁷ But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Rev. 2:8, 10, 8-And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write: The first and the last, who ^[a]was dead, and has come to life, says this... ¹⁰ Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, so that you will be tested, and you will have tribulation for ten days. ^[b]Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

Matt. 10:28-30- Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy

both soul and body in ^[x]hell. ²⁹ Are not two sparrows sold for a ^[y]cent? And *yet* not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. ³⁰ But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

Heb. 13:20-21-Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep ^[g]through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
