

- 9) What is inside (outline)? <u>5 part outline</u> 10) What makes the book different? <u>Emphasis on believe</u>



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

Cross References

John 4:40-So when the Samaritans came to Jesus, they were asking Him to stay with them; and He stayed there two days.

John 4:3- He left Judea and went away again into Galilee.

John 4:39- From that city many of the Samaritans believed in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all the things that I *have* done."

John 4:41- Many more believed because of His word;

John 4:48- So Jesus said to him, "Unless you *people* see signs and wonders, you *simply* will not believe."

John 2:23- Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name, observing His signs which He was doing.

John 20:29- Jesus said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you believed? Blessed *are* they who did not see, and *yet* believed."

Romans 10:17- So faith *comes* from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

John 2:23- Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name, observing His signs which He was doing.

James 4:2- You lust and do not have; *so* you commit murder. You are envious and cannot obtain; *so* you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask.

Matt 12:39- But He answered and said to them, "An evil and adulterous generation craves for a sign; and *yet* no sign will be given to it but the sign of Jonah the prophet

1 Cor 1:22-23- For indeed Jews ask for signs and Greeks search for wisdom; ²³ but we preach Christ crucified, to Jews a stumbling block and to Gentiles foolishness

John 20:29- Jesus said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you believed? Blessed *are* they who did not see, and *yet* believed."

1 John 5:14-This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

John 1:3- All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.

John 2:11-This beginning of *His* signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him.

Acts 16:31- They said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household."

Acts 18:8- Crispus, the leader of the synagogue, believed in the Lord with all his household, and many of the Corinthians when they heard were believing and being baptized.

Hebrews 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
