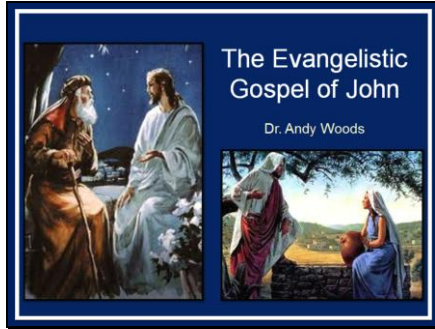


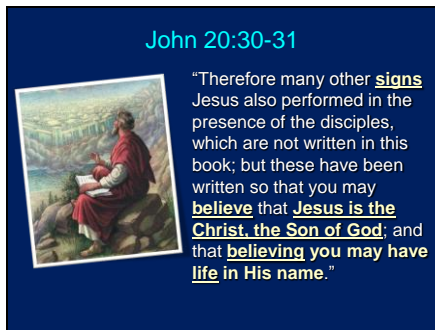



Cross References

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.

1 Pet 5:4-And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.

John 8:9-Then those who heard *it*, being convicted by *their* conscience, went out one by one, beginning with the oldest *even* to the last. And Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

1 John 2:2-and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for *those of* the whole world.

1 Pet 5:2-3-shepherd the flock of God among you, exercising oversight not under compulsion, but voluntarily, according to *the will of* God; and not for sordid gain, but with eagerness; ³ nor yet as lording it over [\[a\]](#) those allotted to your charge, but proving to be examples to the flock.

Gen 4:1-Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, and said, "I have acquired a man from the LORD." (NKJV)

Eph 3:6- that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel

John 1:48-Nathanael said to Him, "How do You know me?" Jesus answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you."

Luke 4:3-And the devil said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread."
