



### **Cross References**

John 2:19-21- Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." <sup>20</sup> The Jews then said, "It took forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?" <sup>21</sup> But He was speaking of the temple of His body.

Matt 26:61- and said, "This man stated, 'I am able to destroy the temple of God and to rebuild it in three days."

Acts 21:28-29- crying out, "Men of Israel, come to our aid! This is the man who preaches to all men everywhere against our people and the Law and this place; and besides he has even brought Greeks into the temple and has defiled this holy place." <sup>29</sup> For they had previously seen Trophimus the Ephesian in the city with him, and they supposed that Paul had brought him into the temple.

Mark 7:13-*thus* invalidating the word of God by your tradition which you have handed down; and you do many things such as that.

John 9:16-Therefore some of the Pharisees were saying, "This man is not from God, because He does not keep the Sabbath." But others were saying, "How can a man who is a sinner perform such signs?" And there was a division among them.

- John 14:6- Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.
- 2 Cor 11:13-15-For such men are false apostles, deceitful workers, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ. <sup>14</sup> No wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. <sup>15</sup> Therefore it is not surprising if his servants also disguise themselves as servants of righteousness, whose end will be according to their deeds.
- Matt 5:31-32-It was said, 'WHOEVER SENDS HIS WIFE AWAY, LET HIM GIVE HER A CERTIFICATE OF DIVORCE'; <sup>32</sup> but I say to you that everyone who divorces his wife, except for *the* reason of unchastity, makes her commit adultery; and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery.
- Matt 5:38-39-You have heard that it was said, 'AN EYE FOR AN EYE, AND A TOOTH FOR A TOOTH.' <sup>39</sup> But I say to you, do not resist an evil person; but whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also.
- John 7:27-However, we know where this man is from; but whenever the Christ may come, no one knows where He is from.
- Ps 34:15-16-The eyes of the LORD are toward the righteous And His ears are *open* to their cry. <sup>16</sup> The face of the LORD is against evildoers, To cut off the memory of them from the earth.
- Ps 145:19-He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He will also hear their cry and will save them.
- Prov 15:29-The LORD is far from the wicked, But He hears the prayer of the righteous.
- John 9:2-3-And His disciples asked Him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he would be born blind?" <sup>3</sup> Jesus answered, "*It was*

neither *that* this man sinned, nor his parents; but *it was* so that the works of God might be displayed in him."

Matt 12:24-But when the Pharisees heard *this*, they said, "This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons."

Isa 29:18-On that day the deaf will hear words of a book, And out of *their* gloom and darkness the eyes of the blind will see

Isa 35:5-Then the eyes of the blind will be opened And the ears of the deaf will be unstopped

Isa 42:7-To open blind eyes, To bring out prisoners from the dungeon And those who dwell in darkness from the prison.

New Scofield Study Bible-"For a Jew to be put out of the synagogue meant that he was ostracized by everyone."

Edersheim-"The Rabbinists enumerate twenty-four grounds for excommunication, of which more than one might serve the purpose of the Pharisees."

John 16:2- They will make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering service to God.

John 15:18-20- If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before *it hated* you. <sup>19</sup> If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, because of this the world hates you. <sup>20</sup> Remember the word that I said to you, 'A slave is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, <sup>21</sup> equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
