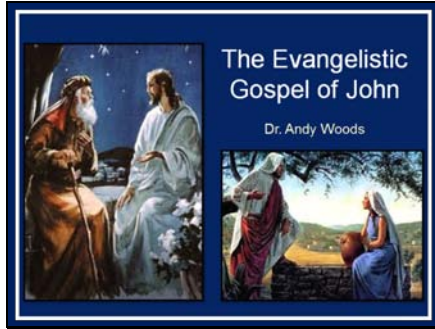


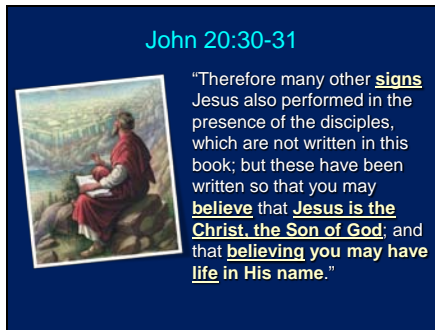

Cross References

John 7:14- But when it was now the midst of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and *began to* teach.

John 1:4-5-In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. ⁵ The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

John 1:8-9-He was not the Light, but *he came* to testify about the Light. There was the true Light which, coming into the world, enlightens every man.

1 John 1:5-This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.

Gen 1:3-Then God said, “Let there be light”; and there was light.

Gen 1:14-19- Then God said, “Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be for signs and for seasons and for days and years; ¹⁵ and let them be for lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth”; and it was so. ¹⁶ God made the two great lights, the greater light to govern the day, and the lesser light to govern the night; *He made* the stars also. ¹⁷ God placed

them in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth, ¹⁸ and to govern the day and the night, and to separate the light from the darkness; and God saw that it was good. ¹⁹ There was evening and there was morning, a fourth day.

Isa 49:6-He says, “It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob and to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also make You a light of the nations So that My salvation may reach to the end of the earth.

Zech 14:6-7-In that day there will be no light; the luminaries will dwindle. ⁷ For it will be a unique day which is known to the LORD, neither day nor night, but it will come about that at evening time there will be light.

Rev 21:23-24-And the city has no need of the sun or of the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp *is* the Lamb. ²⁴ The nations will walk by its light, and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it.

John 3:19-This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil.

Mark 7:13- *thus* invalidating the word of God by your tradition which you have handed down; and you do many things such as that.

Deut 17:6-On the evidence of two witnesses or three witnesses, he who is to die shall be put to death; he shall not be put to death on the evidence of one witness

Deut 19:15-A single witness shall not rise up against a man on account of any iniquity or any sin which he has committed; on the evidence of two or three witnesses a matter shall be confirmed.

John 5:31-If I *alone* testify about Myself, My testimony is not true.

John 3:17-For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him

John 5:22-For not even the Father judges anyone, but He has given all judgment to the Son

John 5:26-27-For just as the Father has life in Himself, even so He gave to the Son also to have life in Himself; ²⁷ and He gave Him authority to execute judgment, because He is *the* Son of Man.

John 5:37- And the Father who sent Me, He has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time nor seen His form.

John 5:18- For this reason therefore the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Him, because He not only was breaking the Sabbath, but also was calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God.

John 8:41- You are doing the deeds of your father.” They said to Him, “We were not born of fornication; we have one Father: God.

John 14:6- Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me

John 2:4- And Jesus said to her, “Woman, what does that have to do with us? My hour has not yet come.

John 7:6-Jesus said to them, “My time is not yet here, but your time is always opportune.

John 7:30- So they were seeking to seize Him; and no man laid his hand on Him, because His hour had not yet come

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, ²¹ equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
