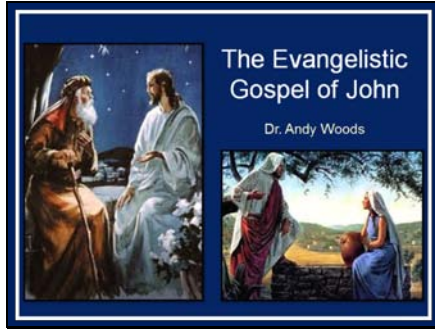


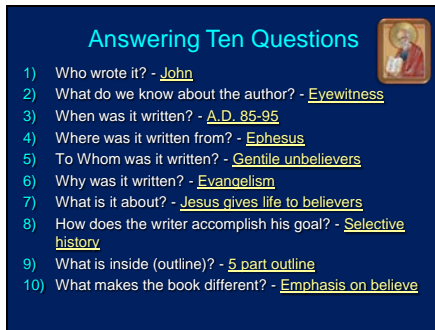



The Nations of Pentecost

Pentecost, a Jewish feast also known as the Feast of Weeks, marked the completion of the barley harvest. On this annual holiday about 50 days after the resurrection of Jesus, Jewish people from throughout the Roman Empire were gathered in the city of Jerusalem to observe this great religious holiday. When the Holy Spirit was poured out on the apostles, they began to speak with "other tongues," and these people from other nations understood them perfectly (Acts 2:5-11). This map shows the different regions of the Roman Empire represented in Jerusalem on the Day of Pentecost.



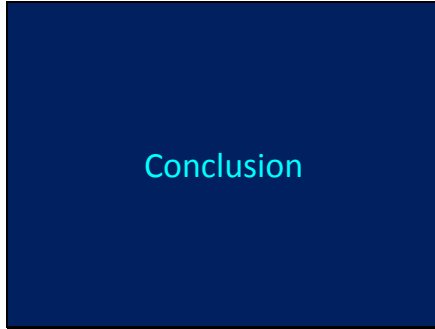

Cross References

Matthew 14:21-There were about five thousand men who ate, besides women and children.

John 1:43-The next day He purposed to go into Galilee, and He *found Philip. And Jesus said to him, “Follow Me.”

John 14:8-9-Philip said to Him, “Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us.”⁹ Jesus *said to him, “Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how *can* you say, ‘Show us the Father’?”

John 1:40-41-One of the two who heard John *speak* and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. ⁴¹ He found first his own brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which translated means Christ).

Matthew 14:21-There were about five thousand men who ate, besides women and children.

1 Thess. 5:18- in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
