Cross References

Matthew 14:21-There were about five thousand men who ate, besides women and children.

John 1:43-The next day He purposed to go into Galilee, and He *found Philip. And Jesus said to him, "Follow Me."

John 14:8-9-Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us." ⁹ Jesus *said to him, "Have I been so long with you, and *yet* you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how *can* you say, 'Show us the Father'?

John 1:40-41-One of the two who heard John *speak* and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. ⁴¹ He found first his own brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which translated means Christ).
