Cross References

Matt 4:13-and leaving Nazareth, He came and settled in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali.

Mark 1:21-They went into Capernaum; and immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and *began* to teach.

Mark 2:1-When He had come back to Capernaum several days afterward, it was heard that He was at home.

Matt 13:55-Is not this the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary, and His brothers, James and Joseph and Simon and Judas?

Acts 8:27-So he got up and went; and there was an Ethiopian eunuch, a court official of Candace, queen of the Ethiopians, who was in charge of all her treasure; and he had come to Jerusalem to worship

Exod 12:5-Your lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old; you may take it from the sheep or from the goats

Gen 12:3-And I will bless those who bless you, And the one who curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed."

Isa 42:6-I am the LORD, I have called You in righteousness, I will also hold You by the hand and watch over You, And I will appoint You as a covenant to the people, As a light to the nations

Isa 49:6-He says, "It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob and to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also make You a light of the nations So that My salvation may reach to the end of the earth."

Mal 3:1-"Behold, I am going to send My messenger, and he will clear the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple; and the messenger of the covenant, in whom you delight, behold, He is coming," says the LORD of hosts.

Ezek 43:4-5-And the glory of the LORD came into the house by the way of the gate facing toward the east. ⁵ And the Spirit lifted me up and brought me into the inner court; and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.

1 Sam 17:26-Then David spoke to the men who were standing by him, saying, "What will be done for the man who kills this Philistine and

takes away the reproach from Israel? For who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should taunt the armies of the living God?"

1 Cor 1:22-For indeed Jews ask for signs and Greeks search for wisdom

Matt 26:61-and said, "This man stated, 'I am able to destroy the temple of God and to rebuild it in three days."

Ezra 3:12-Yet many of the priests and Levites and heads of fathers' *households*, the old men who had seen the first temple, wept with a loud voice when the foundation of this house was laid before their eyes, while many shouted aloud for joy,

Matt 24:1-Jesus came out from the temple and was going away when His disciples came up to point out the temple buildings to Him.

1 Cor 2:14-But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.

John 7:39-But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

Ps 16:10-For You will not abandon my soul to Sheol; Nor will You allow Your Holy One to undergo decay.

Heb 13:20-21-Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
