

 To Whom was it written? Gentile unbelievers


- Why was it written? Evangelism







Cross References

Matt 11:11-"Truly I say to you, among those born of women there has not arisen *anyone* greater than John the Baptist!

Gen 3:21-The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them

Exod 12:5-'Your lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old; you may take it from the sheep or from the goats

Isa 53:7-He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, So He did not open His mouth

John 3:16-For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life

John 12:32-And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to Myself

1 John 2:2-and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for *those of* the whole world.

John 1:3- All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being

John 8:56-58- "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw *it* and was glad." So the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?" Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am."

1 Sam 16:13- Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon David from that day forward. And Samuel arose and went to Ramah

Isa 42:1- Behold, My Servant, whom I uphold; My chosen one *in whom* My soul delights. I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the nations

Matt 3:16- After being baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove *and* lighting on Him

Ezek 36:24-28- For I will take you from the nations, gather you from all the lands and bring you into your own land. Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances. You will live in the land that I gave to your forefathers; so you will be My people, and I will be your God.

John 3:3-5- Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?" Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

John 1:12-13- But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, *even* to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

John 1:14- And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth

1 John 1:1-3- What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we have looked at and touched with our hands, concerning the Word of Life—and the life was manifested, and we have seen and testify and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was manifested to us—what we have seen and heard we proclaim to you also, so that you too may have fellowship with

us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father, and with His Son Jesus Christ.

2 Sam 7:14- I will be a father to him and he will be a son to Me; when he commits iniquity, I will correct him with the rod of men and the strokes of the sons of men

Ps 2:7- I will surely tell of the decree of the LORD: He said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You

John 1:7-8- He came as a witness, to testify about the Light, so that all might believe through him. He was not the Light, but *he came* to testify about the Light.

Heb 13:20-21- Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen
