
Answering Ten Questions



Cross References

Matt 3:5-6-Then Jerusalem was going out to him, and all Judea and all the district around the Jordan; and they were being baptized by him in the Jordan River, as they confessed their sins.

Isa 42:8-I am the LORD, that is My name; I will not give My glory to another, Nor My praise to graven images.

Dan 9:25-So you are to know and discern *that* from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince *there* will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.

Luke 19:42-saying, "If you had known in this day, even you, the things which make for peace! But now they have been hidden from your eyes

Luke 19:44-and they will level you to the ground and your children within you, and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not recognize the time of your visitation

Deut 18:15-The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your countrymen, you shall listen to him

Deut 18:18-I will raise up a prophet from among their countrymen like you, and I will put My words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him.

John 7:40-41-*Some* of the people therefore, when they heard these words, were saying, "This certainly is the Prophet." Others were saying, "This is the Christ." Still others were saying, "Surely the Christ is not going to come from Galilee, is He?

Acts 3:22-"Moses said, 'THE LORD GOD WILL RAISE UP FOR YOU A PROPHET LIKE ME FROM YOUR BRETHREN; TO HIM YOU SHALL GIVE HEED to everything He says to you.

Mark 7:13-thus invalidating the word of God by your tradition which you have handed down; and you do many things such as that

Matt 11:11-Truly I say to you, among those born of women there has not arisen *anyone* greater than John the Baptist! Yet the one who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he

Heb 13:20-21-Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord, equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen
