"The Almighty Father is undoubtedly the One seated on this throne, as He has been throughout the book (cf. 4:2-3, 9; 5:1, 7, 13; 6:16; 7:10, 15; 19:4; 21:5). He is the One on the throne in Dan. 7:9-10 from which this scene borrows. But the Son sits there with Him (3:21; 22:1, 3, 12; cf. John 5:26-27; Heb. 1:3) and works with Him (John 5:19-21; 10:30; cf. Matt. 25:31 ff.; Acts 10:42; 17:31). This passage has no reference to the Son, but John elsewhere indicates His involvement in judgment (22:12)."

Matt. 25:31-But when the **Son of Man** comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne.

2 Cor. 5:10-For we must all appear before **the judgment seat of Christ**, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. ¹⁷ The world is passing away, and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

Rev. 13:8-All who dwell on the earth will worship him, **everyone whose name has not been written from the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb** who has been slain.

Rev. 17:8-The beast that you saw was, and is not, and is about to come up out of the abyss and go to destruction. And those who dwell on the earth, **whose name has not been written in the book of life from the foundation of the world**, will wonder when they see the beast, that he was and is not and will come.

Luke 10:17-The seventy returned with joy, saying, “Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name.”

Luke 10:20-Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven.

Isa. 64:6-For all of us have become like one who is unclean, And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment; And all of

us wither like a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

Gal. 2:16-nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified.

Rom. 3:20-because by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified in His sight; for through the Law *comes* the knowledge of sin.

Gal. 3:10-For as many as are of the works of the Law are under a curse; for it is written, “CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO DOES NOT ABIDE BY ALL THINGS WRITTEN IN THE BOOK OF THE LAW, TO PERFORM THEM.”

John 5:45-Do not think that I will accuse you before the Father; the one who accuses you is Moses, in whom you have set your hope.

Ps. 14:1-The fool has said in his heart, “There is no God.”

Ps. 19:1-4-The heavens are telling of the glory of God; And their expanse is declaring the work of His hands. ² Day to day pours forth speech, And night to night reveals knowledge.

³ There is no speech, nor are there words; Their voice is not heard. ⁴ Their line has gone out through all the earth, And their utterances to the end of the world. In them He has placed a tent for the sun

Ps. 139:14-for I am fearfully and wonderfully made

Acts 17:24-27-²⁴ The God who made the world and all things in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in

temples made with hands; ²⁵ nor is He served by human hands, as though He needed anything, since He Himself gives to all *people* life and breath and all things; ²⁶ and He made from one *man* every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined *their* appointed times and the boundaries of their habitation, ²⁷ that they would seek God, if perhaps they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us

Rev. 4:11-“Worthy are You, our Lord and our God, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and because of Your will they existed, and were created.”

Matt. 12:36-37-³⁶ But I tell you that every careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment. ³⁷ For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

Jude 14-15-¹⁴ *It was* also about these men *that* Enoch, *in* the seventh *generation* from Adam, prophesied, saying, “Behold, the Lord came with many thousands of His holy ones, ¹⁵ to execute judgment upon all, and to convict all the ungodly of all their ungodly deeds which they have done in an ungodly way, and of **all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him.**”

Luke 16:23-In **Hades** he lifted up his eyes, being in torment, and saw Abraham far away and Lazarus in his bosom.

Jude 7-just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the cities around them, since they in the same way as these indulged in gross immorality and went after strange flesh, are exhibited as an example in **undergoing the punishment of eternal fire.**

John 5:28-29-²⁸ Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice, ²⁹ and will come forth; those who did the good *deeds* to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil *deeds* to a resurrection of judgment.

Acts 24:15-having a hope in God, which these men cherish themselves, that there shall certainly be a resurrection of both the righteous and the wicked.

Isa. 59:1-2-Behold, the LORD'S hand is not so short That it cannot save; Nor is His ear so dull That it cannot hear. ² But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hidden *His* face from you so that He does not hear.

Eph. 5:6-Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.

Luke 12:46-47-⁴⁶ the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect *him* and at an hour he does not know, and will cut him in pieces, and assign him a place with the unbelievers. ⁴⁷ And that slave who knew his master's will and did not get ready or act in accord with his will, will receive many lashes.

Rev. 2:11-He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes will not be hurt by the **second death**.

John 3:3-5-³ Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of

God.”⁴ Nicodemus *said to Him, “How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother’s womb and be born, can he?”⁵ Jesus answered, “Truly, truly, I say to you, **unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.**

Rev. 19:20-And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who performed the signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into **the lake of fire** which burns with brimstone.

Matt. 25:41-Then He will also say to those on His left, ‘Depart from Me, accursed ones, into **the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels.**

Philip. 2:10-so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth

Heb. 9:27-And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this *comes* judgment

Luke 16:27-31-²⁷ And he said, ‘Then I beg you, father, that you send him to my father’s house—²⁸ for I have five brothers—in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.’²⁹ But Abraham said, ‘They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.’³⁰ But he said, ‘No, father Abraham, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent!’³¹ But he said to him, ‘If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead.

Num. 6:24-26-The LORD bless you, and keep you;
