Philip. 4:19-And my God will supply all your **needs** according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Ps. 37:25-I have been young and now I am old, Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken Or his descendants begging bread.

Matt. 6:25-34-<sup>25</sup> “For this reason I say to you, do not be worried about your life, *as to* what you will eat or what you will drink; nor for your body, *as to* what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? <sup>26</sup> Look at the birds of the air, that they do not sow, nor reap nor gather into barns, and *yet* your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not worth much more than they? <sup>27</sup> And who of you by being worried can add a *single* hour to his life? <sup>28</sup> And why are you worried about clothing? Observe how the lilies of the field grow; they do not toil nor do they spin, <sup>29</sup> yet I say to you that not even Solomon in all his glory clothed himself like one of these. <sup>30</sup> But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is *alive* today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, *will He* not much more *clothe* you? You of little faith! <sup>31</sup> Do not worry then, saying, ‘What will we eat?’ or ‘What will we drink?’ or ‘What will we wear for clothing?’ <sup>32</sup> For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. <sup>33</sup> But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. <sup>34</sup> “So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

Rom. 12:2-And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

Gen. 17:17-Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed, and said in his heart, “Will a child be born to a man **one hundred years old**? And will Sarah, who is **ninety years old**, bear *a child*?”

1 Pet. 3:1-6-In the same way, you wives, be submissive to your own husbands so that even if any *of them* are disobedient to the word, they may be won without a word by the behavior of their wives, <sup>2</sup> as they observe your chaste and respectful behavior. <sup>3</sup> Your adornment must not be *merely* external—braiding the hair, and wearing gold jewelry, or putting on dresses; <sup>4</sup> but *let it be* the hidden person of the heart, with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is precious in the sight of God. <sup>5</sup> For in this way in former times the holy women also, who hoped in God, used to adorn themselves, being submissive to their own husbands; <sup>6</sup> just as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, and you have become her children if you do what is right without being frightened by any fear.

Prov. 31:30-Charms are deceitful and beauty is vain, *But* a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised.

Prov. 11:22-*As* a ring of gold in a swine’s snout *So is* a beautiful woman who lacks discretion.
