Gen. 6:11-13-¹¹ Now the earth was corrupt in the sight of God, and the earth was filled with violence. ¹² God looked on the earth, and behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way upon the earth. ¹³ Then God said to Noah, "The end of all flesh has come before Me; for the earth is filled with violence because of them; and behold, I am about to destroy them with the earth.

2 Cor. 6:14-16-¹⁴ Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? ¹⁵ Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? ¹⁶ Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? Gen. 3:6-When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make *one* wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate.

Eph. 1:18- *I pray that* the **eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know** what is the hope of

His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.

John 3:3-Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot <u>see</u> the kingdom of God."

1 Cor. 2:14- But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are **spiritually appraised**.

1 John 2:27-As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as **His anointing teaches you about all things**, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you abide in Him.

Matt. 16:25-25 For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it; but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.

Matt. 19:27-30-²⁷ Then Peter said to Him, "Behold, we have left everything and followed You; what then will there be for us?" ²⁸ And Jesus said to them, "Truly I say to you, that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of Man will sit on His glorious throne, you also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. ²⁹ And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or farms for My name's sake, will receive many times as much, and will inherit eternal life. ³⁰ But many *who are* first will be last; and *the* last, first.

Gen. 12:7-The LORD appeared to Abram and said, "<u>To</u> <u>your descendants I will give this land</u>." So he built an altar there to the LORD who had appeared to him.

Gen. 15:5- And He took him outside and said, "Now look toward the heavens, and count the **stars**, if you are able to count them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be."

Gen. 17:17-Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed, and said in his heart, "Will a child be born to a man <u>one hundred years</u> <u>old</u>? And will Sarah, who is <u>ninety years old</u>, bear *a child*?"

Gen. 18:14- <u>Is anything too difficult for the LORD</u>? At the appointed time I will return to you, at this time next year, and Sarah will have a son.

Gen. 14:13- Then a fugitive came and told Abram the Hebrew. Now he was living by the <u>oaks of Mamre the Amorite</u>, brother of Eshcol and brother of Aner, and these were allies with Abram.

John 4:24-God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and <u>truth</u>.

Gen. 12:7-The LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your descendants I will give this land." So <u>he built an altar there to the LORD who had appeared to him</u>.

Gen. 12:8-Then he proceeded from there to the mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; and **there he built an altar to the LORD** and called upon the name of the LORD.

Rom. 12:1-Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

Matt. 5:13-16-¹³ "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become tasteless, how can it be made salty *again*? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled under foot by men. ¹⁴ "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; ¹⁵ nor does *anyone* light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

2 Cor. 5:20-Therefore, we are <u>ambassadors for Christ</u>, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.
