2 Tim. 4:2-**preach the word**; be ready in season *and* out of season; correct, rebuke, *and* exhort, with great patience and instruction.

Isa. 55:11-So will My word be which goes out of My mouth; It will not return to Me empty, Without accomplishing what I desire, And without succeeding *in the purpose* for which I sent it.

<u>10</u>

Gen. 2:7-Then the LORD God formed the man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and the man became a living person.

<u>11</u>

1 Cor. 10:32-Do not offend <u>Jews</u> or <u>Greeks</u>, or the <u>church</u> of God.

<u>16</u>

Deut. 17:14-17-¹⁴ "When you enter the land which the LORD your God is giving you, and you take possession of it and live in it, and you say, 'I will appoint a king over me like all the nations who are around me,' ¹⁵ you shall in fact appoint a king over you whom the LORD your God chooses. *One* from among your countrymen you shall appoint as king over yourselves; you may not put a foreigner over yourselves, *anyone* who is not your countryman. ¹⁶ In any case, he is not to acquire many horses for himself, nor shall he make the people return to Egypt in order to acquire many horses, since the LORD has said to you, 'You shall never again return that way.' ¹⁷ And he shall not acquire many wives for himself, so that his heart does not turn away; nor shall he greatly increase silver and gold for himself.

<u>24</u>

Hosea 3:5-Afterward the sons of Israel will return and seek the LORD their God and **David** their king; and they will come trembling to the LORD and to His goodness in the last days.

Jer. 30:9-But they shall serve the LORD their God and **David** their king, whom I will raise up for them.

Ezek. 34:23-Then I will appoint over them one shepherd, My servant **David**, and he will feed them; he will feed them himself and be their shepherd.
