Gen. 19:1-Now the <u>two angels</u> came to Sodom in the evening as Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw them, he rose to meet them and bowed down with his face to the ground.

John 8:56-59-⁵⁶ Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw *it* and was glad." ⁵⁷ So the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?" ⁵⁸ Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am." ⁵⁹ Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

<u>3</u>

Philip. 3:9-and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith.

<u>6</u>

Heb. 13:2-Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by this **some have entertained angels without knowing it**.

1 Pet. 4:9-Be hospitable to one another without complaint.

Rom. 12:13-contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality.

<u>8</u>

Mark 10:45- ⁴² Calling them to Himself, Jesus said to them, "You know that those who are recognized as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them; and their great men exercise authority over

them. ⁴³ But it is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant; ⁴⁴ and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be slave of all. ⁴⁵ For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.

Philip. 2:4-8-4 do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others. ⁵ Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷ but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. ⁸ Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Heb. 1:14- Are they not all ministering **spirits**, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation?

Matt. 22:30- For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven.

Gen. 26:28-30-²⁸ They said, "We see plainly that the LORD has been with you; so we said, 'Let there now be an oath between us, *even* between you and us, and let us make a covenant with you, ²⁹ that you will do us no harm, just as we have not touched you and have done to you nothing but good and have sent you away in peace. You are now the blessed of the LORD." ³⁰ Then he made them <u>a feast</u>, and they ate and drank.

Exod. 24:11-Yet He did not stretch out His hand against the nobles of the sons of Israel; and they saw God, and **they ate and drank**.

Gen. 17:21-But My covenant I will establish with Isaac, whom Sarah will bear to you at this season next year.

Gen. 21:1-Then the Lord took note of Sarah as He had said, and the Lord did for Sarah as He had promised.

Gen. 17:17-Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed, and said in his heart, "Will a child be born to a man <u>one hundred years</u> <u>old</u>? And will Sarah, who is <u>ninety years old</u>, bear *a child*?"

Gen. 11:30-Sarai was barren; she had no child.

Gen. 17:17-Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed, and <u>said</u> <u>in his heart</u>, "Will a child be born to a man one hundred years old? And will Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear *a child*?"

Isa. 14:13-But <u>you said in your heart</u>, 'I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God, And I will sit on the mount of assembly In the recesses of the north.

Ps. 139:4-Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, LORD, You know it all.

Matt. 12:24-25-²⁴ But when the Pharisees heard *this*, they said, "This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons." ²⁵ And **knowing their thoughts**, *Jesus* said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself is laid waste; and no city or house divided against itself will stand.

1 Sam. 16:7-But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at the height of his stature, because I have rejected him; for God *sees* not as man sees, for man looks at the outward appearance, but **the Lord looks at the heart**."

Prov. 4:23-Watch over your **heart** with all diligence, For from it *flow* the springs of life.

1 Pet. 3:6-just as **Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord**, and you have become her children if you do what is right without being frightened by any fear.

1 Pet. 3:4-but *let it be* the hidden person of **the heart**, with the imperishable quality of a **gentle and quiet spirit**, which is precious in the sight of God.

<u>14</u>

Matt. 19:26-And looking at them Jesus said to them, "With people this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

1 Pet. 2:12-Keep your behavior excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing in which they slander you as evildoers, they may because of your good deeds, as they observe them, glorify God in **the day of visitation**.

Gen. 17:21-But My covenant I will establish with Isaac, whom Sarah will bear to you at this season next year.

<u>15</u>

Gen. 17:16-I will bless her, and indeed <u>I will give you a son by</u> <u>her</u>. Then I will bless her, and she shall be *a mother of* nations; kings of peoples will come from her.

Gen. 17:18-And Abraham said to God, "Oh that **Ishmael** might live before You!"

Ps. 2:1-4-"He that sitteth in the heavens will **laugh**: The Lord will have them in derision."

Gen. 15:6-Then he believed in the Lord; and He reckoned it to him as righteousness.

Heb. 11:6-And without faith it is **impossible** [adynatos] to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and *that* He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

Heb. 10:4-For it is **impossible** [adynatos] for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins."

Heb. 6:18-so that by two unchangeable things in which it is **impossible** [adynatos] for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.
